 latter part gentle breeze from E.S.E. saw
 and did beyond Eastward saw. Drampful

Sept 2

1854 ^{2nd} Remark onboard Saturday Sept 2 1854
 First part of this day gentle breeze from P.P.W.
 latter part fresh breeze from E. Charles the
 Miller came out of the stream in Lat 38°00 Long 71°40

Sept 3

1854 ^{3rd} Remark onboard Sunday Sept 3 1854
 First part of this day, gentle breeze from E.S.E.
 and rough latter part light air from S.W.
 saw at head of Black River saw at ship's head E

Sept 4

1854 ^{4th} Remark onboard Monday Sept 4 1854
 First part of this day, gentle breeze from P.P.W.
 and foggy latter part light air from P.P.W.
 saw and sail rounded in 33 fathoms of water

Sept 5

1854 ^{5th} Remark onboard Tuesday Sept 5 1854
 First part of this day, gentle breeze from S.W.
 and foggy latter part fresh breeze from S.W.
 made the Oattham at 1 o'clock. E.K. and came
 up the river and anchored in Bourne's Cove
 at 10 o'clock at night in the light of Chatham
