At noon Sat by Obs 40.25 Long by Chron. 46.25 by D.R. Sat 40.15 Long 46.23

1854 Remarks on board Saturday Nov 11 1854 All this day fresh breezes from the North overcast and squally bent flying jib and set it at noon by D.R. Sat 39.54 Long 42.44

98 Remarks on board Sunday Nov 12 1854 First and middle parts strong breezes from N.E. at 8 P.M. reefed mainsail latter part strong gales N.E. & E at 8 A.M. furled mainsail flying jib two reefed fore sail and set try sail at noon by D.R. Sat. 39.03 Long 40.00

Remarks on board Tuesday Nov 14 1854 First part fresh gales from the E.N.E. at 1 P.M. wore ship and stood to North saw a brig standing to the southward middle and latter part moderate and squally heavy rain at 4 A.M. set whole sail At noon Sat by Obs. 38.29 Long 38.55

Remarks on board Wednesday Nov 15 1854 All this day moderate breezes eastward and cloudy saw two Brigs standing to the eastward At noon by D.R. Sat 38.25 Long 37.53

Remarks on board Thursday Nov 16 1854 All this day fresh breezes from S.E. to S.S.W. and clear At noon Sat by Obs 38.49 Long by Chron. 34.42 Sat by D.R. 38.43 Long 34.42

Remarks on board Friday Nov 17 1854 First and middle parts fresh breezes from S.S.W. at 4 P.M. single reefed mainsail latter more moderate at 8 A.M. bore out the reef set 2 aft topsail and stay sail At noon Sat by Obs. 38.30 Long. 30.50 Sat by D.R. 38.31
