

Remarks on board on a Saturday Nov 18<sup>th</sup> 1844  
First part pleasant breezes from  
the S.W. at 5 P.M. wind shifted  
to the W.N.W. thick fog  
set in at 6 P.M. furled the mainsail  
at 1 P.M. hove to at 10 A.M. hove of and  
S.E. at 6. undetwined sail at 10 saw the  
Land.  
At noon Breeze bearing per compass  
E by S 90 miles dist

Remarks on board Sunday Nov 19<sup>th</sup> 1844  
all this day fresh breezes from the  
Westward foggy most of the time at  
P.M. came to anchor and had a morning  
brought of to us furled sails and

Monday Nov 20<sup>th</sup> All there 24 hours fresh  
breezes from NE and cloudy, commenced  
discharging lumber. Mr Seavey is sick with  
a bad cold, so ends this day

Tuesday Nov 21<sup>st</sup> All there 24 hours fresh  
breezes from NE and cloudy finished  
discharging lumber. Mr Seavey still remains  
sick, so ends this day

Wednesday Nov 22<sup>d</sup> All there 24 hours fresh  
breezes from the NE, commenced taking  
in Oranges so ends this day

Thursday Nov 23<sup>d</sup> All there 24 hours  
fresh breezes from NE and cloudy  
finished taking in Oranges. Mr Seavey still  
remains sick so ends this day

Friday Nov 24<sup>th</sup> All there 24 hours fresh  
breezes from the N.W. at 11 A.M.  
sailed from from Foul, for Boston, left  
Sloop Susan Hall for Boston, and Brig Alva, for  
New York so ends

Saturday Nov 25<sup>th</sup> First part fresh breezes from  
N.W. at 2 P.M. the S.E. Point of Foul bore  
E.S.E. dist 15 miles at 4 P.M. single reefed  
Mainsail at 5 P.M. double reefed Foresail and  
furled Flying jib, at 10 P.M. tore the Mainsail  
by the Single reef bingle hauled it down and  
set Towsail, latter part moderate breeze  
from N.W. employed in repairing Mainsail  
hove reef out of Foresail, and set Flying jib  
saw a Brig steering E.S.E. Mr Seavey quite  
well. Lat at noon 37° 31' N Long 31° 07' W

Sunday Nov 25<sup>th</sup> First part moderate breezes  
from N.W. to West. Middle fresh breezes from  
South to West with rain double reefed Fore  
and Mainsail furled Flying jib, and took Bount  
of off Main latter part moderate breezes  
from N.W. at 12 M. took ship to the  
Westward. Mr Seavey very sick with Fever.  
Lat at noon 37° 40' N Long 32° 00' W

Monday Nov 27<sup>th</sup> First part moderate breezes  
from N.W. hove reef out of Foresail and set  
Flying jib Middle Cabin hauled down Mainsail  
latter part fresh breezes from NE set  
whole sail: saw a ship and Bark steering  
S.E. Mr Seavey very sick  
Lat at noon 37° 17' N Long 33° 07' W

Tuesday Nov 28<sup>th</sup> First part fresh breezes from  
E.N.E. at 5 P.M. double reefed sail, and furled  
Flying jib. Middle and latter part heavy breezes  
from NE and cloudy at 6 P.M. furled Mainsail  
and jib, at 10 A.M. set jib and Towsail  
Mr Seavey very sick. Lat at noon 36° 33' N Long 35° 50' W

Wednesday Nov 29<sup>th</sup> First part heavy gales from  
E.N.E. furled Towsail and jib and run under  
double reefed Foresail, latter part more  
moderate from NE set Towsail Mr Seavey very  
sick. Lat at noon 35° 11' N Long 39° 20' W
