

Thursday Nov 30<sup>th</sup> First part fresh breezes from NE and cloudy, set Flying jib, latter part moderate breezes from ENE with squalls of rain, hove reefs out of Foresail and set single reefed Mainsail Mr Seavey very sick Lat at noon 35°27'N Long 42°50'W

Friday Dec 1<sup>st</sup> First part moderate breezes from ENE and clear Middle light winds with a heavy swell, hauled down Fore and Mainsail, latter part moderate breezes from SW and clear, set whole sail employed in repairing Staysail. Mr Seavey very sick Lat at noon 35°24'N Long 44°00'W

Saturday Dec 2<sup>d</sup> First part pleasant breezes from SW. Middle light winds from NW with rain. Latter part fresh breezes from ENE and cloudy with a heavy swell from NW. Single reefed Mainsail, Pinned a Dutch Galat steering SE. Mr Seavey very sick Lat at noon 35°21'N Long 46°00'W

Sunday Dec 3<sup>d</sup> First part fresh breezes from ENE and cloudy Middle wind SE wore ship double reefed Foresail, latter part fresh breezes from the South with rain squalls. Mr Seavey very sick Lat at noon 35°10'N Long 48°50'W

Monday Dec 4<sup>th</sup> First part fresh breezes from the South and clear latter part heavy gales from SSE at 10 PM furled Mainsail and set Fuzsail, furled Flying jib, at 10 AM furled jib and close reefed Foresail heading to the NW. Mr Seavey very sick Lat at noon 35°20'N Long 52°00'W

Tuesday Dec 5<sup>th</sup> First part heavy gales from SSE to SSW with rain, at 4 PM hove two on the Starboard tack under Fuzsail at 5 PM wore Moderate set three reefed Foresail at 12 mid Wind North with a heavy breeze wore ship to the WNW and set jib Mr Seavey very sick Lat at noon 35°40'N Long 52°45'W

Wednesday Dec 5<sup>th</sup> First part fresh breezes from SW and clear, at 8 PM a sea broke into the jib and split it, hauled it down and furled it, Middle and latter part heavy gales from SW to NW, wore two under three reefed Foresail, and Fuzsail. Mr Seavey very sick Lat at noon 35°47'N Long 53°00'W

Thursday Dec 7<sup>th</sup> First part heavy gales from SW to West, at 4 PM wore ship to the South Middle more moderate wind from NWN and rain unbent jib to repair latter part calm with a heavy swell from SW and NW set Flying jib and hauled down Foresail employed in repairing jib Mr Seavey very sick Lat at noon 35°54'N Long 54°00'W

Friday Dec 8<sup>th</sup> First part moderate breezes from SW and clear repaired the jib and bent it set whole sail, at 8 PM fresh breezes from SW with a heavy head swell single reefed Mainsail, double reefed Foresail, and furled Flying jib at 10 PM furled Mainsail and set Fuzsail, latter part heavy gales from SW at 8 AM furled jib. Mr Seavey still very sick Lat at noon 35°10'N Long 55°00'W

Saturday Dec 9<sup>th</sup> all there 24 hours heavy gales from SW to NW first part rain latter part cloudy, at 10 AM set Bob jib at 8 PM wore ship to the SW, a very heavy swell from the NW. Mr Seavey very sick Lat at noon 35°42'N Long 58°12'W
