

Sunday Dec 10<sup>th</sup> First part heavy breezes from  
NNW Lying too under Topsail Double reefed Foresail  
and piece of jib. Latter part fresh breezes  
from North to NE and cloudy with a heavy  
swell from NNW running under Double reefed  
Foresail and jib. Mr Seary very sick

Lat at noon 35°00' N Long 54°33' W

Monday Dec 11<sup>th</sup> First part fresh breezes  
from East to SE and cloudy with a heavy  
swell from NNW. Latter part moderate  
breezes from SE to SW and squally, set  
single reefed Foresail and Main sail, and flying  
jib. Mr Seary is a little better

Lat at noon 34°55' N Long 53°45' W

Tuesday Dec 12<sup>th</sup> First part moderate breezes  
from SSW and cloudy, Middle fresh breezes  
from South and squally, Double reefed Main  
and furlled Flying jib at 10 PM furlled  
Mainsail. Latter part heavy gales from  
SSW with rain Sunday to the NW under  
Double reefed Foresail and Bunt out of  
jib, at 10 AM wore reefed Foresail  
and furlled jib. Mr Seary very sick

Lat at 35°52' N Long 52°03' W

Wednesday Dec 13<sup>th</sup> First part fresh gales  
from WSW and rain Middle moderate  
breezes from WNW to North and squally  
at 5 PM wore ship to the Westward latter  
part heavy gales from NNW Lying too  
under Topsail and Close reefed Foresail  
Mr Seary still very sick

Lat at noon 35°35' N Long 52°10' W

Thursday Dec 14<sup>th</sup> First part fresh gales from  
NNW Middle and latter part light winds  
from NW to SW and calm hauled down  
Foresail. Mr Seary very sick

Lat at noon 35°30' N Long 52°28' W

Friday Dec 15<sup>th</sup> First part moderate breezes from  
SSW and squally Middle fresh breezes Double  
reefed Mainsail. Latter part fresh gales from  
SE and rain Mr Seary some better

Lat at 35°50' N Long 54°12' W

Saturday Dec 16<sup>th</sup> First part fresh gales from  
SE and cloudy at 2 PM spoke Brig Frances  
Ellen of Rockland, with Son of Fore Topsail  
and yard Foretopgallantmast, and Main Topmast  
Latter part heavy gales from SE with heavy  
rain squally furlled Mainsail, and jib, and  
laid under Double reefed Foresail, settled  
down at 8 AM came into the Gulf Stream  
Mr Seary still very sick

Lat at noon 34°08' N Long 53°20' W

Sunday Dec 17<sup>th</sup> At 12 mid heavy gales from SE  
at 2 PM the gale moderated and the wind  
shifted to the Westward, set jib and Topsail  
Middle fresh breezes from NNW with a bad  
sea at 10 PM in furling the jib Hove  
it out of the Leach Rope, Latter part heavy  
breezes from NW and cloudy at 8 AM wore  
ship to the Westward, unhooked jib to repair  
Mr Seary very sick

Lat at noon 33°11' N Long 55°12' W

Monday Dec 18<sup>th</sup> First part moderate breezes  
from NW and cloudy repaired jib and bent  
it Middle calm, with a heavy swell set  
Flying jib and hauled down Foresail at 5  
PM set Main jib and furlled Flying jib  
latter part from 1 AM to 7 AM fresh breezes  
from SE with rain set Foresail Double  
reefed, and Topsail from 7 AM to 12 mid  
more moderate wind from SSW set Double  
reefed Mainsail and Flying jib at 10 AM  
left the Gulf Stream. Mr Seary very sick
