

Tuesday Dec 19th First part Moderate breezes from SSW and rainy, at 5 PM the wine came with a squall from NW. Three reefed Foresail, parted Mainsail, jib, and Flying jib and set Tropsail. Middle and latter part fresh gales from NW saw two ships steering ESE at 8 AM were ship to the NNE. Mr Seary very sick
Lat at noon 32° 36' N Long 83° 18' W

Wednesday Dec 20th All there 24 hours fresh breezes from NW to NNE. At 2 PM set double reefed Mainsail and Flying jib at 5 PM parted Mainsail and set Tropsail at 10 PM double reefed Foresail at 12 mid set Flying jib and double reefed Mainsail
Mr Seary very sick

Lat at noon 40° 10' N Long 88° 07' W

Thursday Dec 21st First part fresh breezes from the North and cloudy at 2 PM spoke Whaling Bark Lexington of New Bedford 24 hours out Boston on a Cruise. Middle moderate breezes from NW at 1 AM hauled up to the North at 8 AM hove reefs out of Foresail and double reefed Mainsail. Latter part wind SW and snow at 10 AM sounded in 45 fathoms muddy bottom, at 12 mid sounded in 25 fathoms
Lat at noon 40° 31' N Long 70° 10' W

Friday Dec 22^d First part fresh breezes from SSW and a Snow storm, at 2 PM double reefed Foresail Middle fresh gales from West to NW with Snow bore to under Tropsail and double reefed Foresail. Latter part Moderate breezes from North to NE and Snowy made sail and stood to the NW. Mr Seary quite sick

Lat at noon 40° 25' N Long 70° 33' W

Saturday Dec 23^d First part moderate breezes from the Eastward and cloudy sleazy, never for Gay Head. Middle fresh breezes from the North parted Mainsail and jib. Latter part moderate breezes from NE and Snowy set Mainsail and jib, at 12 mid saw Block Island bearing NW dist 11 miles Mr Seary very sick

Lat at noon 40° 50' N Long 71° 39' W

Sunday Dec 24th First part moderate breezes from ENE and Snowy at 8 PM passed Block Island. Latter part fresh gales from ESE to SSE at 11 PM saw Block Island lights bearing SW at 2 AM saw Point Judith Light bearing N3W, at 5 AM it blowing fresh from ESE bore up for Newport at 8 AM anchored in Newport harbor. Mr Seary very sick

Monday Dec 25th First part fresh breezes from SE and rainy. Latter part moderate breezes from SW and Snowy, put Mr Seary on shore in the Hospital he having been sick the whole passage

Tuesday Dec 26th All there 24 hours calm and Snowy still at anchor in Newport

Wednesday Dec 27th First part moderate breezes from NE and Snowy. Latter part fresh gales from ESE and rain. Still at anchor in Newport

Thursday Dec 28th First part Moderate breezes from NE and thick rainy weather. Middle and latter part fresh breezes and Snowy George Tarrimort a destitute Seaman put on board at Funchal by the American Consul went on shore and absconded
