

Friday Dec 29th First part fresh breezes from NE and thick weather. Latter part moderate breezes from NNE and clearing at 12 mid sailed from Newport for Boston in Co with several sail of Buz and Scher.

Saturday Dec 30th First part fresh breezes from the North with rain and snow at 3 PM. Passed the Light Boat off the Town & Rip at 4 PM anchored in Tarpanter Cove. Latter part fresh gales from SSE and very cold.

Sunday Dec 31st All these 24 hours fresh breeze from NNE and clear at 10 AM sailed from Tarpanter Cove at 12 mid anchored in Holmer Hole.

Monday Jan 1st First part moderate breeze from the North at 5 AM got under weigh and sailed for Boston, at 10 fresh breeze from NE went down as far as the Light Boat in Cross Rip, and put back into Edgarton for a harbor at 1 PM came to anchor.

Tuesday Jan 2nd All these 24 hours fresh breezes from NE and cloudy still at anchor in Edgarton.

Wednesday Jan 3rd First part fresh breeze from NE and cloudy Middle and latter part calm, fifteen sail of vessels waiting for a chance to go over the Shoals.

Thursday Jan 4th First part calm, latter part moderate breezes from the SNE at 5 AM sailed from Edgarton for Boston.

Friday Jan 5th First part moderate breezes from the NE clear at 3 PM. Passed the Great Round Shoal, at 5 PM. Chatham. Latter part fresh breezes from NE to NW and foggy at 10 passed the high land of Cape Cod.

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Saturday Jan 6th First part fresh breezes from NNE and clear at 7 PM anchored in the Stream.
