fair saw one group of porpoises two seals
Spoke the Bark Sea Flower of New Bedford
saw her 7 months out of Oahu

May 23
1855

Remarks onboard Wednesday
First part of this day gentle breeze from
N.W. and fair latter part wind from
South with a squall from N.E. saw Blackfish

May 24
1855

Remarks onboard Thursday
First part of this day light breeze from
South and cloudy latter part fresh breeze
from S.W. and cloudy missed the Bark Sea

May 25
1855

Remarks onboard Friday
All this day fresh breeze from N.W.
and fair saw one fair bound to the
S.W. saw with Bark Bridgman of
Pahoa 11 months out 30 lbs sperm oil

May 26
1855

Remarks onboard Saturday
First part of this day gentle breeze from
S.W. and cloudy latter part fresh breeze
from N.W. rainy fair two Caribbees
and one Whaling Bark the Brig

May 27
1855

Remarks onboard Sunday
All this day fresh breeze from North and
fair saw the Brig Star of New Bedford
bound North Lat 31° 26' Long 158° 44'

May 28
1855

Remarks onboard Monday
All this day gentle breeze from N.W.
and smooth saw two sails one bound
to the other South saw Blackfish 30 miles out

May 29
1855

Remarks onboard Tuesday
First part of this day gentle breeze from
N.W. and fine latter part gentle breeze from
S.W. at 10 o'clock saw Bermuda light
bearing S. 30° East 20 miles saw at 10
Brig Ocean 12 months out 20 lbs of sperm
saw a Whaling Bark bound to the Westward

May 30
1855

Remarks onboard Wednesday
First part of this day light breeze from
N.W. latter part fresh breeze from S.W.
and cloudy at sunset reefed foresail
Lat 29° 54' Long 162° 24'

May 31
1855

Remarks onboard Thursday
All this day fresh breeze from S.W. and
cloudy at 10 o'clock saw one group of porpoises
and one small boat under full sail 20 miles out

June 1
1855

Remarks onboard Friday
All this day fresh breeze from S.W. and
cloudy saw one group of porpoises at
10 o'clock took in the jibs at
four o'clock again and at 8 o'clock took it in

June 2
1855

Remarks onboard Saturday
All this day fresh breeze from East
and cloudy at 10 o'clock saw one group of porpoises
took one shot out of the about 10 miles out and it

June 3
1855

Remarks onboard Sunday
All this day gentle breeze from S.W. and
fair set the Mainail and Bitter End for the
first time for five days so end this day
Lat 30° 34' Long 161° 13'
