First part of this day fresh breeze from S.W. and cloudy. Latter part gentle breeze from W.S.W. and cloudy. At the Main sail, first time for 14 days. At end of day all well

Aug 2nd
1855

Remarks onboard Thursday

First part of this day gentle breeze from W. by S. Latter part fresh breeze from W. and cloudy. Saw one school of porpoises

Aug 3rd
1855

Remarks onboard Friday

First part of this day fresh breeze from W.S.W. and cloudy. Latter part fresh breeze from S.W. and fair under double reef. Eysail set by

1855

Remarks onboard Saturday

First part of this day fresh breeze from W.S.W. and cloudy. Latter part moderate and cloudy. Saw one school of Blackish. Spoke the Mountain Spring. 1/2 months out. Clear

Aug 5th
1855

Remarks onboard Sunday

All this day gentle breeze from S.W. and fine. Saw Bramble at 10 A.M. went on board of Mountain Spring. Banded until sunset

All this day fresh breeze from S.W. and fine. At 7 A.M. saw the Mountain Spring. Boat in shade of 1/2 mile. Sounded our Boats and struck and killed one. Supposed to make 30. Spoke one of her

Remarks onboard Tuesday

All this day gentle breeze from S.W. and fine with the exception of a shower or two. Started the work at end of day. Boiling

Aug 8th
1855

Remarks onboard Wednesday

First part of this day gentle breeze from W.S.W. and pleasant. Latter part fresh breeze from S.W. and fine. Saw a Sch. Boiling. Supposed to be the Mountain Spring. finishing. Boiling and stored down the boiling. 21. 1/2 of Boddy and 1/2 of Broad

Aug 9th
1855

Remarks onboard Thursday

First part of this day fresh breeze from W.S.W. and cloudy. Latter part very moderate. Too much part of the day under Eysail

Aug 10th
1855

Remarks onboard Friday

First part of this day light air from W.S.W. and fine. Latter part gentle breeze from W.S.W. Saw Bramble. Boiling. Spoke the Richard of Bournemouth. Young. 1/2 months out. Clear

Aug 11th
1855

Remarks onboard Saturday

All this day gentle breeze from W.S.W. and fine. Saw Bramble. Boiling. Supposed to be Bramble

Aug 12th
1855

Remarks onboard Sunday

First part of this day gentle breeze from W.S.W. and fair. Latter part fresh breeze from S.W. with a heavy rain. Wind changed to the N.E.
