Nov 26th 1855 Remarks onboard Monday
first & middle parts fresh breeze from the South with rain the latter part the wind N.W. and Squally Lat 32° 00' Long 34° 00'

Nov 27th 1855 Remarks onboard Tuesday
all this day fresh gales from the N.W. and Squally at noon two ships in sight Lat 32° 20' Long 30° 56'

Nov 28th 1855 Remarks onboard Wednesday
all this day fresh gales from the N.W. at 6 A.M. took in the mainsail & flyjib at 10 set the trysail Lat 32° 24' Long 27° 00'

Nov 29th 1855 Remarks onboard Thursday
first part fresh gales from the N.W. and Squally middle part more moderate set the mainsail latter part the wind S.W. and Cloudy Lat 32° 34' Long 24° 00'

Nov 30th 1855 Remarks onboard Friday
first part fresh gales from the N.W. and Squally at 4 P.M. took in the mainsail and set the trysail at 5 A.M. two reefed the foresail and took in the flyjib latter part more moderate hove the reefs out the foresail and set the flyjib Lat 32° 09' Long 21° 00'

Dec 1st 1855 Remarks onboard Saturday
first part moderate and Squally at 10 P.M. took in the mainsail and flyjib and set trysail latter part fresh gales from the N.W. and Cloudy Lat 31° 23' Long 18° 44'

Dec 2nd 1855 Remarks onboard Sunday
all this day fresh breeze from the N.W. and fine weather all sail set Lat 29° 36' Long 17° 09'

Dec 3rd 1855 Remarks onboard Monday
first part moderate breeze from the N.W. and fine at 4 P.M. made the Island of Tenerife at 5 took in sail middle & latter parts calm

Dec 4th 1855 Remarks onboard Tuesday
first part moderate breeze from the S.E. and fine at 4 A.M. made sperm whales board the boats at 9 came on board took none latter part fresh breeze from the South and rizing at 11 board again for whales struck one part of the line & lost him

Dec 5th 1855 Remarks onboard Wednesday
first part fresh breeze from the South with rain at 4 P.M. took in sail the mainsail & flyjib set the trysail fresh gales & Squally middle and latter parts calm

Dec 6th 1855 Remarks onboard Thursday
first part calm at 5 P.M. took in sail middle part fresh breeze from the South & thick rizing weather at 6 A.M. two reefed the foresail fresh gales and Squally latter part fresh gales and clear
