Dec 1st 1855 Remarks on board Friday
first part fresh breeze from
SSE middle part the same
latter part more moderate
at 4 AM made sail

Dec 2nd 1855 Remarks on board Saturday
first part fresh breeze from the
West at 5 PM took in sail
middle part the wind SEW
at 7 AM made sail latter
part the wind West and fine

Dec 3rd 1855 Remarks on board Sunday
first part the wind to the
Westward and fine weather
cruising off the East side of
Angra Terentura middle and latter
parts moderate breeze and calm

Dec 4th 1855 Remarks on board Monday
first part fresh breeze from the
SEW and squally middle
and latter the wind SE to SEW
and thick squally weather

Dec 5th 1855 Remarks on board Tuesday
first part fresh breeze from
the West at 8 AM calm latter
part fresh gales from the
WSEW at 11 AM wore ship
Lat 26° 47' Long 14° 08'

Dec 6th 1855 Remarks on board Wednesday
first part fresh gales from the
WSEW and squally at 2 PM wore
ship middle part more moderate
the wind SEW wore ship and set the main
sail & fly the latter part the wind
SEW and fine bore the reef out the foresail and
set the outer jib at noon Lat 26° 51' Long 15° 16'

Dec 7th 1855 Remarks on board Thursday
all this day the wind SEW
and fine weather
Lat 25° 12' Long 16° 01'

Dec 8th 1855 Remarks on board Friday
all this day light breeze from
the SEW and fine weather
at 1 AM sounded got bottom
17 fathoms at 8 AM made the
land at noon Lat 24° 25' Long 15° 58'

Dec 9th 1855 Remarks on board Saturday
first part fine breeze from the
North and weather latter part
calm

Dec 10th 1855 Remarks on board Sunday
first part moderate breeze
from the North and fine
at 7 PM came to anchor
in 10 fathoms of water middle
part calm at 8 AM got
under way latter part the wind
SEW

Dec 11th 1855 Remarks on board Monday
first part fresh breeze from
the SEW at 3 PM came to
anchor in Cintra Bay middle
and latter fresh breeze from
the North

Dec 12th 1855 Remarks on board Tuesday
all this day moderate breeze
from the SEW and fine
weather
