all this day fresh breeze from
the S.W. and fine weather
at 8 A.M. got under way and
ran down to the wreck of the
Mountain Spring. Could not get
hoale of her and ran back
and came to anchor in the Bay

Jan 14th 1856 Remarks onboard Monday
first part moderate breeze
from the North middle
part and parts fresh breeze
from the S.E. to East

Jan 15th 1856 Remarks onboard Tuesday
first part fresh breeze from the
S.E. and squally at 5 P.M. moved
Ship at 5 A.M. toward the Boat
at and took a cruise in the
Bay found a dead Body
took it on Shore and Buryed it

Jan 16th 1856 Remarks onboard Wednesday
the first and middle parts
moderate and calm latter
part fresh breeze from the West

Jan 17th 1856 Remarks onboard Thursday
all this day fresh breeze from
the S.E. and thick weather

Jan 19th 1856 Remarks onboard Saturday
all this day the Wind S.W. and
fine weather at 7 A.M. got under
way in Gintur at 10 A.M. came
to anchor in Goree Bay

Jan 20th 1856 Remarks onboard Sunday
first part moderate breeze
from the S.W. and fine weather
middle and latter parts calm
at 8 A.M. saw a large Whale

Jan 21st 1856 Remarks onboard Monday
first part moderate breeze
from the S.W. middle and
latter parts fresh gales from
the North and thick Weather

Jan 22nd 1856 Remarks onboard Tuesday
all this day fresh breeze from
the S.E. and thick weather

Jan 23rd 1856 Remarks onboard Wednesday
first and middle parts fresh
breeze from the S.E. and thick
latter part more moderate and
fine Weather

Jan 24th 1856 Remarks onboard Thursday
all this day fresh breeze from
the S.E. and thick weather

Jan 25th 1856 Remarks onboard Friday
all this day moderate breeze
from the S.E. at 5 A.M. struck a
Whale and killed it at noon
took him A long side
