Jan 26th 1856 Remarks onboard Saturday all this day moderate and calm at 2 P.M. commenced to cut in the whale at noon finish cutting

Jan 27th 1856 Remarks onboard Sunday first part moderate breeze from the S.E. at 4 P.M. commenced Boiling middle fresh breeze latter part more moderate

Jan 28th 1856 Remarks onboard Monday first part moderate and fine weather at finish Boiling

Jan 29th 1856 Remarks onboard Tuesday all this day moderate and fine weather at 6 A.M. got way in Goree Bay

Jan 30th 1856 Remarks onboard Wednesday first part fresh breeze from the S.E. and fine weather at 3 P.M. came to anchor in Cintar Bay middle and latter parts moderate and fine Stowed Down the Oil

Jan 31st 1856 Remarks onboard Thursday all this day moderate and thick weather cleared up the Decks at 6 A.M. lowered the Boats and took a cruise in the Bay at 10 came onboard

Feb 1st 1856 Remarks onboard Friday first and middle parts moderate and squally at 5 P.M. let go the Starboard Anchor latter part moderate & fine at 10 A.M. got under way in Cintar Bay

Feb 2nd 1856 Remarks onboard Saturday first part fresh breeze from the S.E. at 3 P.M. came to anchor in Goree Bay middle and latter parts the third East A heavy swell heaving into the Bay

Feb 3rd 1856 Remarks onboard Sunday all this day fresh breeze from the S.E. and fine weather

Feb 4th 1856 Remarks onboard Monday first and middle parts moderate and fine at 2 P.M. the S. & Soper came in the Bay and anchored latter part moderate at 7 A.M. saw a Whale at 10 Struck & killed her in 60 with the E. Dickson & S. Soper took the Whale alongside the Soper

Feb 5th 1856 Remarks onboard Tuesday first part fresh breeze from the S.E. middle part the same at 6 A.M. forward the Boats at 7 came onboard latter part fresh gales from the S.E. & clear

Feb 6th 1856 Remarks onboard Wednesday first part moderate breeze and fine middle and latter parts fresh gals from the S.E. and clear weather

Feb 7th 1856 Remarks onboard Thursday all this day fresh gales from the S.E. and clear weather

Feb 8th 1856 Remarks onboard Friday all this day moderate and thick W at 9 A.M. saw a Whale Struck & killed it & took it alongside the Sch John C. Smith so end this day
