Feb 24th 1856
Remarks onboard Sunday
first part fresh gales from the North and clear weather the Sch. C. Erickson Boiling Middle part moderate and fine latter part moderate breeze and fine weather

Feb 25th 1856
Remarks onboard Monday
all this day moderate and fine weather at 6 A.M. toward the Boat at 7 the Starboard Boat struck a Whale killed her took it alongside the S.R. Loper and commenced cutting

Feb 26th 1856
Remarks onboard Tuesday
all this day moderate breeze from the S.E. and fine weather at 4 P.M. saw a Whale toward the Boats at 5 came onboard took nothing at 7 A.M. toward and took a cruise at noon came onboard

Feb 27th 1856
Remarks onboard Wednesday
first part fresh breeze from the S.E. Middle & latter parts more moderate at 7 A.M. toward saw a Whale & lost sight of her at 10 came onboard & took up the Boats so ends this day

Remarks onboard Thursday
first part fresh gales from the S.E. at 2 P.M. saw a large Whale chased & lost sight of her at 4 came onboard and took up the Boats at 5 P.M. saw a Whale loun and chased till dark came on board Middle & latter parts more moderate

Feb 29th 1856
Remarks onboard Friday
first part fresh gales and fine weather Middle and latter parts moderate and fine weather

Mar 1st 1856
Remarks onboard Saturday
first part fresh gales from the S.E. and fine Middle and latter parts moderate and fine weather at 6 A.M. toward the Boats at 7 saw a Whale and lost sight at noon came onboard

Mar 2nd 1856
Remarks onboard Sunday
first part fresh breeze from the S.E. Middle and latter parts moderate and fine weather

Mar 3rd 1856
Remarks onboard Monday
first part fresh breeze and fine weather Middle and latter parts moderate breeze from the East

Mar 4th 1856
Remarks onboard Tuesday
all these 24 hours moderate and fine weather at 7 A.M. saw a Whale toward took chase lost sight of her at 10 came onboard
