Mar 7th 1856 Remarks onboard Friday
first part Moderate and fine
Went to the Whale Anchored
& Bowed her took the other along
side the John E. Smith Middle and
latter parts Calm at 11 A.M. Struck
A Whale at noon Dred the harpoon
and lost her

Mar 8th 1856 Remarks onboard Saturday
first part Moderate breeze from
the Westward at 4 P.M. got the
Sew under way and run down
to the Sunkers Whales & came to anchor
at 5 A.M. got the Whale alongside
and commenced cutting latter part calm

Mar 9th 1856 Remarks onboard Sunday
all this day Moderate and fine
weather at 2 P.M. got under way
worked up to the Bay & came to anchor
at 5 P.M. commenced Boiling.

Mar 10th 1856 Remarks onboard Monday
first part Moderate and fine
middle and latter parts fresh
breeze from the S.W. and Cloudy
at 7 A.M. finish Boiling Struck
and killed A Whale took it alongside
the C. Dickson

first part Moderate and fine weather
Stored the Oil 55 bls and Cleared
up Decks Middle and latter parts
fresh breeze from the W.S.W. with
A heavy Squall A hearing into the bay

Mar 12th 1856 Remarks onboard Wednesday
first part fresh breeze from the
Westward with A heavy roll
at 4 P.M. run the Caddy & hawser
out Middle & latter parts the wind
S.E. at 9 A.M. took up the Caddy
hawser all hands employed cleaning Bone

Mar 13th 1856 Remarks onboard Thursday
all this day Moderate breeze from
the North and fine weather

Mar 14th 1856 Remarks onboard Friday
all this day Moderate breeze and
fine weather took A Cruise in the
Boats Saw nothing

Mar 15th 1856 Remarks onboard Saturday
all this day fresh breeze and
fine weather

Mar 16th 1856 Remarks onboard Sunday
all this day Moderate and
fine weather

first part fresh breeze from
the S.W. with A heavy roll
