first and middle parts fresh gales from the S.E. at 7 o'clock more moderate saw a whale toward the Boat. Struck & killed her a large Cow Whale at noon took her alongside the John E. Smith. latter part fresh gales from S.

Mar 21<sup>th</sup> 1856 Remarks on board Friday  
all this day fresh gales from the S.E. employed Chasing Bone

Mar 22<sup>th</sup> 1856 Remarks on board Saturday  
first part fresh gales at 1 P.M. saw a whale leaved and took chase so rough & windy lost sight of her. came on board at 4 saw whale took chase to near right. came on board took up the Boat. Middle and latter parts more moderate

Mar 23<sup>th</sup> 1856 Remarks on board Sunday  
first part fresh breeze from the S.E. Middle and latter parts moderate & calm fine weather

Mar 24<sup>th</sup> 1855 Remarks on board Monday  
first part moderate and fine weather Middle and latter parts fresh breeze from the North with a heavy Roll

all this day fresh gales from the North with a heavy Roll

Mar 26<sup>th</sup> 1855 Remarks on board Wednesday  
first part fresh gales from the North Middle & latter parts more moderate and fine got the Oil from the J. E. Smith 32 bbls and stowed it down

Mar 27<sup>th</sup> 1855 Remarks on board Thursday  
first part fresh breeze from the S.E. Middle and latter parts more moderate at 7 o'clock saw a whale toward the Boat & took chase at 8 came on board thick Cloudy weather

Mar 28<sup>th</sup> 1855 Remarks on board Friday  
first part fresh breeze from the S.E. with a heavy Roll Middle and latter parts fresh gales from the S.E. at 5 o'clock the E. Erickson parted her chains and put to Sea

Mar 29<sup>th</sup> 1855 Remarks on board Saturday  
the first part fresh gales from the S.E. the E. Erickson in sight taking off & on the Bay Middle latter part more moderate & fine

Mar 30<sup>th</sup> 1855 Remarks on board Sunday  
first part fresh gales from the S.E. Middle & latter parts more moderate at noon the Sch. Wm. Martin came to Anchor in the Bay

Mar 31<sup>st</sup> 1855 Remarks on board Monday  
first part fresh gales Middle and latter part more moderate at 7 o'clock the Wm. Martin got under way
