first part fresh gales at 4 P.M.
saw a Whale to leeward did
not ~~see~~ loward the E Dickson
in Sight Middle and latter parts
the same

Apr 7th 1856 Remarks onboard Monday
all this day fresh gales
from SSE to ESE and clear

Apr 8th 1856 Remarks onboard Tuesday
all this day fresh gales from the SSE
at 11 A.M. saw Whale loward and
Chared so Windy came onboard

all this day fresh gales from
the SSE and Clear weather

Apr 10th 1856 Remarks onboard Thursday
all this day fresh breeze from the
SSE to ESE and Cloudy
the E Dickson in Sight

Apr 11th 1856 Remarks onboard Friday
first part fresh breeze from the
SE Middle part more moderate
at 10 A.M. saw Whale loward and
Struck & killed her latter part fresh breeze

Apr 12th 1856 Remarks onboard Saturday
all this day fresh breeze at 8 P.M.
took the Whale alongside at 7 A.M.
commenced cutting finish at 10 A.M.

Apr 13th Remarks onboard Sunday
all this day fresh gales from SE to SSE
at 4 P.M. commenced Boiling

Apr 14th Remarks onboard Monday
first part fresh gales from SE to SSE
at 11 P.M. finished Boiling the E Dickson
came in & Struck Middle & latter part
the same

Apr 15th 1856 Remarks onboard Tuesday
all this day fresh gales from the SE
at 3 P.M. saw a Whale loward the
Boats rough & Windy could not
go to her at 5 P.M. came onboard
at 8 A.M. Delivered 32 bls Oil to the
E Dickson & Cleared up the Decks

Apr 16th 1856 Remarks onboard Wednesday
all this day fresh breeze from SSE
to SE and Clear weather
