May 22nd 1856 Remarks onboard Thursday
first part and middle parts
fresh breeze from the W & N
with thick Cloudy weather
latter part fresh gales from
the North and thick weather

May 23rd 1856 Remarks onboard Friday
first part fresh breeze from the
W & N middle and latter parts fresh
gales from the Westward with rain

May 24th 1856 Remarks onboard Saturday
first part fresh gales from the
W & N and thick weather blowing under
the lee off Terceira at 4 P.M. two
reefed the foresail & took the jib
middle part the same the latter
part more moderate at 7 A.M.
set the jib and wore ship

May 25th 1856 Remarks onboard Sunday
first part fresh breeze from
the Westward at 6 P.M. took in jib
middle and latter the same
at 6 A.M. set the jib

May 26th 1856 Remarks onboard Monday
first part fresh breeze from the
middle part calm latter part
fresh breeze from the Westward
Saw a Whaling Bark

May 27th 1856 Remarks onboard Tuesday
first part fresh breeze from the
W & N at 2 P.M. two reefed the foresail
at 6 took in the jib middle part
fresh gales with rain to latter part
the wind W and more moderate
made sail and wore ship to the S

May 28th 1856 Remarks onboard Wednesday
all this day moderate and fine
weather at 5 A.M. made sail
the Island Terceira in sight

May 29th 1856 Remarks onboard Thursday
first part calm middle & latter
parts moderate breeze from the S.W.
with fine weather

May 30th 1856 Remarks onboard Friday
first and middle parts moderate
breeze from the Westward at 5 A.M.
made St. Michael latter part
moderate breeze from the North & rain

May 31st 1856 Remarks onboard Saturday
first part moderate and rainy
middle and latter parts fresh
breeze from the S.W. & S.E.
and Cloudy Saw finbacks

June 1st 1856 Remarks onboard Sunday
first and middle parts fresh
breeze from the S.E. and Cloudy
latter part more moderate at
noon, came to in St. Michael

June 2nd 1856 Remarks onboard Monday
all this day fresh breeze from the North
took on board 40 lbs of water the
Starboard Hatch ashore on liberty

June 3rd 1856 Remarks onboard Tuesday
all this day fresh breeze from the
S.E. finish taking on board
the water and recruit the Harbour
Hatch ashore
