parts Moderate breeze from the
S.W. and fine Saw Finback &
one Brig Bound East

the North at 6 A.M. Saw a School
of Sperm Whales toward the
boat. The Whale going quick
could not get on at noon came
onboard at 3 P.M. & toward
again the Whales in sight at sunset
came onboard Saw nothing out the
Boats Lat 36° 30' Long 35° 00'

June 25th 1856 Remark onboard Wednesday
all this day Moderate and Calm
Lat 35° 56' Long 36° 15'

June 26th 1856 Remarks onboard Thursday
first part Moderate breeze from
the South Middle and latter parts
fresh breeze from the S.W. Saw
porpoises Lat 35° 36' Long 36° 42'

June 27th 1856 Remarks onboard Friday
first part fresh breeze from the
S.W. Middle and latter parts
fresh gales and Squally at 7 reefed
the foresail Lat 33° 15' Long 38° 03'

June 28th 1856 Remarks onboard Saturday
first and middle parts Moderate
with Squalls of rain latter part
fresh breeze from the S.W. Saw a
Whaling Bark and Blackfish
hauled took one Lat 35° 28' 38° 46'

June 29th 1856 Remarks onboard Sunday
all this day fresh breeze from the
S.W. and fine Lat 35° 32' Long 40° 19'
