Remarks onboard Thursday

1856 All of these 24 hours strong N.E. trades. at 3 p.m. came to anchor in Contra Bay in 5 fms of water the Barque Spaten and Erickson of Provincetown at anchor in the Bay. So ends this day.

Dec 19. th Remarks onboard Friday

1856 All of this day gentle N.E. trades. at 5 A.M. hoisted the Boats and cruised in the Bay. at noon came on board. all hands employed at Ship's Duty. So ends these 24 hours.

Dec 20. th Remarks onboard Saturday

1856 All of these 24 hours strong N.E. trades. at 6 A.M. lowered the Boats and cruised in the Bay. at 10 A.M. came on board. Saw nothing. at 2 P.M. the *Schr. Montigama* came to anchor in the Bay. So ends this day.

Dec 21. th Remarks onboard Sunday

1856 All of these 24 hours gentle N.E. trades. at 6 A.M. the lowered the Boats and cruised in the Bay. at 11 A.M. came on board. at 5 P.M. the *Schr. Montigama* farboard Boat. Struck a Whale and killed it. So ends this day.

Dec 22. th Remarks onboard Monday

1856 All of these 24 hours gentle N.E. trades. So ends this day All Well.

Dec 23. th Remarks onboard Tuesday

1856 All of these 24 hours gentle N.E. trades. at 6 A.M. lowered the Boats and cruised in the Bay. at 5 P.M. the *E. Erickson* Boat Struck a whale and killed it. at 11 came on board so ends this day.

Dec 24. th Whaling Voyage in the North Atlantic

1856 Remarks onboard Wednesday
All of these 24 hours strong N.E. trades. at 6 A.M. lowered the Boats and took a cruise in the Bay. at noon came on board. Saw nothing. So ends this day.

Dec 25. th Remarks onboard Thursday

1856 first part of this day strong N.E. trades. at 6 A.M. lowered the Boats and cruised. at noon came on board. Saw nothing. middle and latter part more moderate. So ends these 24 hours.

Dec 26. th Remarks onboard Friday

1856 first part of this day gentle breeze from the N. at 6 A.M. lowered the Boats and cruised in the Bay. at noon came on board. Saw nothing middle and latter part strong gales from the North. So ends these 24 hours.

Dec 27. th Remarks onboard Saturday

1856 All of these 24 hours strong gales from the N. at 6 A.M. lowered the Boats and cruised. at noon came on board. Saw nothing William & Volney & Watchman of Nantucket came to anchor in the Bay 2 months out 30 blb Whale. So ends this day.

Dec 28. th Remarks onboard Sunday

1856 first part of these 24 hours gentle N.E. trades at 6 A.M. lowered the Boats and cruised in the Bay. at 10 came on board. Saw nothing at 11 A.M. the *Schr. Silver Cloud* came to anchor in the Bay 45 D out Clean. So ends this day.

Dec 29. th Remarks onboard Monday

1856 All of these 24 hours strong N.E. trades. at 2 P.M. the *Schr. Olive Clark* came to anchor in the Bay 7 months out Clean. the *Jh. Duval* anchored in the Bay 30 days out Clean. So ends this day.
