moderate. Saw porpoises so ends this day
Lat 22.0 Lon 15.0

Jan 13. th

1857

Remarks onboard Tuesday
All of these 24 hours strong N.E. trades
Saw Porpoise and Finbacks so ends this day
Lat 20.2 Lon 17.20

Jan 14. th

1857

Remarks onboard Wednesday
All of these 24 hours strong N.E.
trades. Saw a finback. all hands
imployed at ships duty so ends this day
Lat 20.10 Lon 19.40

Jan 15. th

1857

Remarks onboard Thursday
All of these 24 hours strong N.E.
trades. Saw Porpoises and Finbacks
so ends these 24 hours Lat 19.21 Lon 20.0

Jan 16. th

1857

Remarks onboard Friday
All of these 24 hours strong N.E.
trades. Saw Porpoises so ends this day
Lat 19.20 Long 22.0

Remarks onboard Saturday
All of these 24 hours strong N.E.
trades at 8 A.M. made the Island of St.
Barth W 20. miles so ends this day

1857

Remarks onboard Sunday
All of these 24 hours strong N.E.
trades at 3 P.M. saw a Humpback
going quick to the windward at 4.00
P.M. came too anchor in modorra
Bay in 10 f. water so ends this day

Remarks onboard Monday
All of these 24 hours strong N.E. trades
at 11 A.M. saw a Humpback going quick
too the windward did not lower the Boats
all hands imployed setting up the fore
& main rigging so ends these 24 hours

Jan 19. th

1857

Remarks onboard Tuesday
first part of these 24 hours strong
N.E. trades middle and latter part
moderate trades all hands imploy
at ships duty so ends these 24 hours

Jan 20. th

1857

Remarks onboard Wednesday
All of these 24 hours strong N.E. trades
at 7 A.M. on bent the foresail and
cut the leech rope off and roped it
on again it being too slack on the
leech at sundown saw a Humpback
so ends this day

Jan 21. th

Remarks onboard Thursday
All of these 24 hours strong N.E. trades
all hands imployed at ships duty so ends this day

Jan 22. th

1857

Remarks onboard Friday
All of these 24 hours strong N.E. trades
and rainy. Bent the foresail so ends this day

Jan 23. th

1857

Remarks onboard Saturday
All of these 24 hours strong N.E. trades
at 4 A.M. weighed anchor and went too sea
so ends this day

Jan 24. th

1857

Remarks onboard Sunday
All of these 24 hours strong N.E. trades
at 4.00 P.M. came too anchor on the
S.W. side of the Island of Saint. Nichols
in 14 f. of water at Sundown saw
a Humpback so ends these 24 hours
