Remarks onboard Monday
All of these 24 hours strong N E Trades
at 6 o'clock A M got under way and
cruised on the sou W side of the Island
at 8 A M saw a shoal of Blackfish near
the Boats at 8 past 8 the Larbord Boat
struck one & killed it and took it along
side and cut it in so ends this day

Jan 26. th

1857

Remarks onboard Tuesday
first part of these 24 hours strong N E
trades at sundown the island of
Saint ~~Michael~~ Nicholas bearing S S E 20th distant
at 2 o'clock A M wore ship and stood in
for the Island so ends these 24 hours

Jan 27. th

1857

Remarks onboard Wednesday
first part of these 24 hours calm
at 8 o'clock A M saw 2 Humpbacks
lowered the Boats & chased then at
noon came onboard middle and latter
part strong N E Trades so ends this day

Jan 28. th

1857

Remarks onboard Thursday
All of these 24 hours strong N E
trades at 9 A M came to anchor in
Saint Georges Bay and boiled the
Blackfish made 12 bbls so ends this day

Jan 29. th

1857

Remarks onboard Friday
All of these 24 hours strong N E Trades
at 9 A M Cpt Holmes took ~~one~~ ^{one} ~~barrel~~ ^{barrel}
of ~~that~~ Blackfish oil on shore too trade
at 4 P M returned so ends this day

Jan 30. th

1857

Remarks onboard Saturday
All of these 24 hours gentle N E Trades
at 6 A M got under way saw 2
Humpbacks at 7 lowered the Boats at 8
the Lar Boat struck at 9 o'clock A M
drewed from her so ends this day

Jan 31. th

Remarks onboard Sunday
All of these 24 hours gentle
N E Trades at one P M saw
a whale lowered the Boats and
chased untill 3 o'clock at 5
P M came to anchor in Saint Georges Bay
so ends these 24 hours

Feb 1. th

1857

Remarks onboard Monday
All of these 24 hours strong N E
trades & squally at 6 A M got under
way at 8 spoke the Brig Passama of
Sag Harbor 2 months out 400 bbls whale
at 8 past 11 came to anchor in Saint Georges Bay
so ends this day

Feb 2. th

1857

Remarks onboard Tuesday
All of these 24 hours strong N E Trades
at A M the Larbord ~~boat~~ watch went on
liberty so ends these 24 hours

Feb 3. th

1857

Remarks onboard Wednesday
All of these 24 hours strong N E Trades
at 6 P M the Larbord watch returned
Thommas was a little intoxicated
when he came on board and swore he would not do
no more duty th Aft then told him to go forward
Thommas said he would not go Aft then put
him in irons. he swore he would knife the
Aft & sink the Messel as soon as he got out
of irons so ends these 24 hours all well
