Remarks onboard Thursday
All of these 24 hours strong N E trades at 6 p M got under way to go to Saint George to discharge Thomas at noon came too anchor at port prias in 4 f of water so ends this day

Feb 5th

1857

Remarks onboard Friday
All of these 24 hours strong N E trades at 2 o'clock p M Cpt Holmes went on shore at 3 p M the first Lieutenant of the united States Sloop of war Saint Luc came on board to see Thomas the Lieutenant asked Thomas if he would go to his duty Thomas said ~~no~~ he would not Cpt Holmes told Thomas he mite have his choice too go on shore or on board of the man of war. Thomas said he would go on board of the man of war at 6 p M Thomas went on board of the Man of war so ends these 24 hours

Feb 6th

1857

Remarks onboard Saturday
first part of these 24 hours strong N E trades 3 p M got under way and went too sea middle part of this day moderate latter part strong trades so ends these 24 hours

Feb 7th

Remarks onboard Sunday
All of these 24 hours strong N E trades at Sundown the island of Saint Nicholas passing it by 6 15 miles distance at 9 A M saw a Humpback lowered the Boats and chased at noon came on board so ends this

Feb 8th

1857

Remarks onboard Monday
All of these 24 hours strong N E trades at 4 p M came too anchor at Saint Nicholas in 1 f of water so ends this day

Feb 9th

1857

Continued
Remarks onboard Tuesday
All of these 24 hours strong N E trades at 6 A M got under way and cruised saw finbackes and porpoises so ends this day

Feb 10th

1857

Remarks onboard Wednesday
All of these 24 hours strong N E trades at 4 p M Cpt Holmes went on shore to ship a Man at 6 returned saying at anchor at Saint Nicholas so ends this day

Feb 11th

1857

Remarks onboard Thursday
All of these 24 hours strong N E trades at 7 A M got under way and cruised at 8 saw 2 Humpbacks lowered the Boats and chased them at 10 A M came on board so ends these 24 hours

Feb 12th

1857

Remarks onboard Friday
All of these 24 hours strong N E trades at 4 p M came to anchor in Saint George Bay in 5 f of water at 7 A M got under way at 9 saw 2 Humpbacks lowered the Boats chased them at noon came on board so ends these 24 hours

Feb 13th

1857

Remarks onboard Saturday
All of these 24 hours fresh N E trades at 4 p M came to anchor in Saint George Bay in 5 f of water. Cpt Holmes went on shore & shipped John Antoon at 6 returned so ends these 24 hours

Feb 14th

1857

Remarks onboard Sunday
All of these 24 hours strong N E trades saw 2 Humpbacks so ends this day

Feb 15th

1857

Remarks onboard Monday
All of these 24 hours strong N E trades at 8 A M got under way at 9 saw 2 Humpbacks lowered and chased them at noon came on board so ends this day
