Feb. 16th

Remarks onboard Monday
All of these 24 hours strong S E trades
at 11 Am came to anchor in Saint George's Bay
all hands this employ at Ships duty
So ends this day

Feb. 17th

Remarks onboard Tuesday
All of these 24 hours strong S E
trades at 8 A M saw a Humpback
off shore all hands employ at Ships duty
So ends these 24 hours

Feb. 18th

Remarks onboard Wednesday
All of these 24 hours strong S E trades
at 6 P M the Perry Charles Miller got to
sea so ends these 24 hours

Feb. 19th

Remarks onboard Thursday
First of these 24 hours gentle S E
trades at 3 P M saw a Humpback
going quick off shore at 7 A M got
under way saw Porpoises so ends this day

Feb. 20th

Remarks onboard Friday
All of these 24 hours strong S E trades
at 2 P M came to anchor in Saint George's
Bay & on land the Flying J. got to sea in
three clocks so ends these 24 hours

Feb. 21st

Remarks onboard Saturday
All of these 24 hours fresh S E trades
at 1 P M sent the Flying J. at 2 saw a
breach to the seaward so ends this day

Feb. 22nd

Remarks onboard Sunday
All of these 24 hours fresh trades at 3 P M
the Starboard Boat went on shore at 4 o'clock
& then toward the Boats after Humpbacks the Starboard
went on one struck & killed but at 7 took her along
at 7 A M commenced cutting in

Feb. 23rd

Remarks onboard Monday
All of these 24 hours fresh trades at 3 P M
finished cutting and cleared up decks at 7
A M the Starboard Boat went on shore at
11 returned at 11 A M made sail and land after
hump backs Starboard boat cut stow: held for
2 hours and then so ends these 24 hours

Feb. 24th

Remarks onboard Tuesday
All these 24 hours strong S E trades & at 11 Am
to anchor at 7 commenced boiling at 1 A M made
sail at 9 finished boiling so ends this day

Feb. 25th

Remarks onboard Wednesday
All these 24 hours gentle trades saw hump backs
at 4 P M came to anchor so ends this day

Feb. 26th

Remarks onboard Thursday
First part of these 24 hours moderate trade, still
and later part strong trade saw hump backs
muching of them at 7 A M made sail so ends
this day

Feb. 27th

Remarks onboard Friday
All these 24 hours gentle S E trades and at 11
saw a Whale toward the Boats came in
& Starboard boat struck and sunk down at 4 P M
came to anchor & sent J. Bay at 6 P M
Made sail so ends this day

Feb. 28th

Remarks onboard Saturday
These 24 hours gentle trades at 4 P M toward
after hump backs Starboard boat went on an star
At 6 o'clock here along side at seven down the sea
end of Saint Nicholas being S. P. to 10
Miles distance at 7 A M commenced boiling
saw hump backs so ends this day
