Remarks onboard Friday June 5th 1857 All of these 24 hours gentle breeze from N.E. and fine weather Saw two Shoals of Porpoises caught one Dolphin Saw two Sails supposed them to be Merchantman. bound W by S So ends this

Lat 26° 35' Long 86° 58'

June 6th Remarks onboard Saturday June 6th 1857 First part of this day gentle breeze from N.E. and fine weather middle and saw 2 Shoals of Porpoises caught 3 dolphin latter part of this latter part gentle breeze from S.E. and fine

June 7th Saw 4 Sails supposed them to be Merchantman

Lat 26° 14' Long 86° 46'

July 7th Remarks onboard Sunday July 7th 1857 All of these 24 hours gentle breeze from S.E. and fine weather Saw three Shoals of Porpoises Saw Grampuses Saw 4 Sails supposed them to be Merchantman So ends this day Lat 26° 02' Long 86° 40'

June 8th Remarks onboard Monday July 8th 1857 First part of this day calm middle part gentle breeze from N.E. latter part fresh breeze from E.N.E. Saw three Sails supposed them to be Merchantman Saw three Shoals of Porpoises So ends this day Lat 25° 43' Long 85° 03'

June 9th Remarks onboard Tuesday June 9th 1857 All of this day gentle breeze from E.N.E. and fine weather at sunset with the Schrs S.K. Saper seven months out 100 Mls Spurn 100 Mls of Humphback at 10 P.M. raised a large school of Small Spurn Whale toward three boats and struck 2. a loose whale got the line around his flukes and drew the line out of one whale the 3 boat took his whale along side the other 2 boats gave chase after the school So ends this day Lat 25° 45' Long 85° 48'

June 10th 1857

Remarks onboard Wednesday June 10th 1857 All of these 24 hours gentle breeze from N.E. and fine weather at 4 P.M. the boats gave up the chase at 6 came on board Whales bound N.W. at 6 P.M. commenced cutting at seven finished cutting. Saw 4 Shoals of Porpoises Saw Grampuses Saw dolphin Saw a Steamboat So ends this Lat 25° 50' Long 85° 30'

June 11th

Remarks onboard Thursday June 11th 1857 All of these 24 hours gentle breeze from N.E. and fine weather at 3 P.M. commenced boiling at 5 P.M. finished boiling Saw 2 Shoals of Porpoises caught 3 dolphin Steam Boat bound N.W. So ends this day Lat Long

June 12th 1857

Remarks onboard Friday June 12th 1857 All of these 24 hours gentle breeze from N.E. and fine weather Saw 2 Shoals of Porpoises Saw Grampuses & dolphin Saw three Sails supposed them to be Merchantman bound S.E. Stowed down the oil there being 8 Mls of head & 1 Mls of head So ends this day Lat 25° 46' Long 85° 51'

June 13th 1857

Remarks onboard Saturday June 13th 1857 First and middle parts of these 24 hours gentle breeze from E.N.E. and fine weather latter part of this day fresh breeze from N.E. Saw one school of Porpoises caught 4 dolphin saw eight sails supposed them to be Merchantman Lat 25° 31' Long 84° 38'

June 14th 1857

Remarks onboard Sunday June 14th 1857 First part of this day fresh breeze from E.N.E. Steaming S.E. bound out of the Bay middle part equally latter part fresh breeze from S.E. by E. and cloudy Saw eight Sails supposed them to be Merchantman Lat 24° 31' Long 83° 50'

June 15th

Remarks onboard Monday June 15th 1857 All of these 24 hours fresh breeze from N.E. by E. and cloudy at 9 P.M. singlet reefed the Mainsail and Foresail at 10 P.M. took in Mainsail & set the trysail at 1 P.M. made all sail again Saw 4 Sails of Merchantman bound out of the Bay So ends this day Lat 23° 22' Long 83° 04'
