1857 Remarks onboard Sunday July 12th 1857
First part of this day gentle breeze from
S.W. and fine saw two shoals of Blackfish
bound N.W. middle and latter part of
this day Wind W by N and squally with
much rain saw a ship supposed to
be a Merchantmen bound N.W. So ends the

July 13th Remarks onboard Monday July 13th 1857
First and middle part of these 24 hours
gentle breeze from S.W. with squalls of
rain latter part Wind West and fine
saw 4 shoals of Porpoises and one shoal
of Blackfish So ends this day Lat 33° Long 47°

July 14th Remarks onboard Tuesday July 14th 1857
First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze
from West and squally latter part
gentle breeze from S.W. and fine weather
saw one shoal of Porpoises Lat 34° Long 45°

July 15th Remarks onboard Wednesday July 15th 1857
All of these 24 hours gentle breeze
from S.W. and fine weather saw
two shoals of Porpoises 2 Gray Grampuses
and dolphin Benjamin North on latter
Lat 34° 40' Long 45° 41'

July 16th Remarks onboard Thursday July 16th 1857
First and middle part of these 24 hours
gentle breeze from East and fine weather
at 10 A.M. raised a shoal of Blackfish
toward all three Boats and gave chase
but could not get hold latter part
of this day gentle breeze from N.E. and
fine weather saw two shoals of Porpoises
Lat 34° 50' Long 45° 11'

First and middle part of this day gentle
breeze from N.E. and fine weather
saw 2 shoals of Porpoises and one shoal
of Blackfish latter part light
baffling Wind gained with S.E.
Montezuma of Provincetown 8 months
out 160 lbs Whale had taken a small
Spurw Whale the day before saw one
ship supposed to be a Merchantmen
bound S.E. Lat 35° 20' Long 45° 22'

July 18th Remarks onboard Saturday July 18th 1857
All of this day gentle breeze from S.W.
and fine weather saw 4 shoals of Porpoises
saw Grampuses saw two sails of Merchantmen
and 2 Montezumas Lat 34° 25' Long 44° 09'

July 19th Remarks onboard Sunday July 19th 1857
First and middle part of these 24
hours gentle breeze from S.W. and
fine weather picked up a Spanker
boom caught two Dolphin latter part
Wind West saw two sails supposed
them to be Merchant bound S.E.
Lat 34° 50' Long 43° 20'

July 20th Remarks onboard Monday July 20th 1857
All of these 24 hours gentle breeze from
S.W. and fine weather saw 3 shoals
of Porpoises saw Grampuses and squid
So ends this day Lat 35° 05' Long 43° 20'

July 21th Remarks onboard Tuesday July 21th 1857
All of this day gentle breeze from S.W.
and fine weather saw 2 shoals of
Porpoises saw Grampuses at 10 A.M. saw
a wreck and run for it
Benjamin North sick and of duty
me don't no what is the matter with him
Lat 34° 23' Long 42° 51'
