July 22th Remarks onboard Wednesday July 22nd
1857 All of these 24 hours gentle breeze from S.W. and fine weather at one p.m. Boarded the Wreck and got 4 Boat loads of wood Spoke the Brig Medford of Orleans Export 10 months out 280 Bls Whale 130 Bls of Bone Saw 3 shoals of Porpoises Saw Grampuses So ends this day Lat 35.35 Long 41.15

July 23th Remarks onboard Thursday July 23rd
1857 All of this day gentle breeze S.W. and fine weather Saw 3 shoals of Porpoises Saw Grampuses caught one Porpoise the Brig Medford in sight So ends this day Lat 37.05 Long 40.33

July 24th Remarks onboard Friday July 24th
1857 First and middle part of this day gentle breeze from S.W. and fine weather latter part fresh breeze from S.W. and squally Saw Grampuses and one shoal of Porpoises Saw Brig Medford So ends this day Lat 38.00 Long 39.00

July 25th Remarks onboard Saturday July 25th
1857 First and middle part of this day fresh breeze from S.W. and squally latter part fresh breeze from N.W. laying too under too reef Foresail and Tysail Saw 2 shoals of Porpoises Benjamin Worth is no better the Brig Medford in sight Lat Long None

July 26th Remarks onboard Sunday July 26th
1857 First and middle part of this day fresh breeze from N.W. laying too under single reef Foresail Tysail and Stormsail Benjamin Worth no better Lat 38.20 Long 38.20

July 27th Remarks onboard Monday July 27th
1857 First and middle part of this day fresh breeze from N.W. and foggy latter part latter part Wind North and thick fog Saw Grampuses Saw 4 shoals of Porpoises Saw 4 Sails supposed them to be Merchantmen Lat 36.32 Long 34.47

July 28th Remarks onboard Tuesday July 28th
1857 All of this day gentle breeze from N.E. and smoky Saw Grampuses and Porpoises Saw 4 Sails supposed them to be Merchantmen Benjamin Worth is better So ends this day Lat 35.00 Long 33.48

July 29th Remarks onboard Wednesday July 29th
1857 First and middle part of this day gentle breeze from North and fine on bent the Mainsail to repair it Saw Grampuses and Porpoises Saw 2 Sails supposed them to be Merchantmen latter part gentle breeze from N.W. and smoky all hands employed repairing Mainsail Benjamin Worth is better and thinks he shall be able too do his duty in a few days

July 30th Remarks onboard Thursday July 30th
1857 All of this day gentle breeze from N.W. and smoky Saw 2 shoals of Porpoises Saw Grampuses Saw 2 Sails supposed them to be Merchantmen All hands employed repairing Mainsail Benjamin Worth has gone on duty So ends this day Lat 39.50 Long 32.50
