Aug 16th Remarks onboard Sunday Aug 16th 1857
 All of these 24 hours gentle breeze from
 N by E and fine weather at 1 p.m. Cpt
 Holmes and a Boat's Crew went on
 Board of the Bark to help cut the Whale
 at 6 p.m. took the Head along Side
 of the Schooner at 10 a.m. commenced
 cutting at 10 finished. Saw Grampuses
 Saw too Whaling Barks also in
 company with Bark Nauticus of
 Nantucket Cpt Hardie Benjamin Worth
 has got a pain in his Side and is
 of duty So a Flores harring W N W
 30 miles distance So ends this day

Aug 17th Remarks onboard Monday Aug 17th 1857
 All of these 24 hours gentle breeze from
 North and fine weather at 2 p.m.
 commenced boiling the Head
 Saw Grampuses at Sundown Flores
 harring N W 30 miles distance
 Benjamin Worth has got a pain in
 his Side and in his chest and Back
 and a ~~cut~~ in his hand trying to
 hit a ~~cut~~ and is of duty
 Joseph Marvil Stopped on a Harpoon
 and cut his Foot bad and is off
 duty in company with Bark Nauticus
 of Nantucket So ends this day

Aug 18th Remarks onboard Tuesday Aug 18th 1857
 All of this day gentle breeze from N E
 and fine weather at 5 p.m. finished
 Boiling the Head there being 43 bls
 at 7 a.m. Cpt Hardie came on board
 of the Schr and divided the Head
 then Cpt Holmes went on board of the Bark
 and divided the Body there being 40 bls
 of Head and 68 bls of Body Flores
 harring W N W distance 30 miles

Aug 19th Remarks onboard Wednesday Aug 19th 1857
 First and middle part of these 24 hours
 gentle breeze from N E and fine
 weather Saw Grampuses and one School
 of Porpoises Saw three Sails supposed
 them to be Merchantmen also a
 Whaling Schr. Latter part of this
 day gentle breeze from W by N
 Stowed down the oil there
 being 22 bls of H and 32 bls of Body
 the Island of Pico harring S E
 distance 40 miles So ends this day

Aug 20th Remarks onboard Thursday Aug 20th 1857
 All of these 24 hours gentle breeze
 from W by N Saw Grampuses
 Saw too Whaling Schrs also 2 too
 Barks took the Harbor Boat on
 and repaired her at Sundown
 the Island of Pico harring
 S E distance 10 miles So ends this day

Aug 21th Remarks onboard Friday Aug 21th 1857
 First and middle part of
 this day gentle breeze from
 W by N and Cloudy latter part
 fresh breeze from North and
 rainy. Saw too Whaling Barges
 also too Merchantmen Saw Grampuses
 at Sundown the Island of Pico
 harring E by S distance 8 miles

Aug 22th Remarks onboard Saturday Aug 22th 1857
 All of these 24 hours fresh breeze from
 N E and equally Saw Grampuses
 Saw three Whaling Ships Sailing
 off and on at Pico got up the Chain
 and sent them and tried to get too
 anchor at Sundown Pico harring
 N E 2 miles distance
