First part of these 24 hours
fresh breeze from North and
smoky middle and latter part
of this day fresh breeze from
N East with Squals Saw one school
of Porpoises Lat 34.14 Long 110.15

Aug 31th

1857

Remarks onboard Monday Aug 31th
First and middle part of this day
fresh breeze from N East with
Squals Saw two schools of Porpoises
latter part fresh breeze from
East N East with Squals Lat 34.15 Long 110.15

Sept 1st

1857

Remarks onboard Tuesday Sept 1st
First part of this day gentle
breeze from N East with Squals
middle and latter part gentle
breeze from N N East and fine
weather Saw one school of Porpoises.
Lat 34.14 Long 110.15

Sept 2nd

1857

Remarks onboard Wednesday Sept 2nd
All of these 24 hours gentle breeze
from N N East and fine weather
at 8 p.m. raised a dead sperm
whale had been dead about 4
to 5 days. took her along side
and cut her in at 8 A.M.
commenced boiling Saw one school
of Porpoises Saw a ship supposed
to be a Merchantmen bound
S East. Lat 34.25 Long 110.15

Sept 3rd

1857

Remarks onboard Thursday Sept 3rd
All of this day gentle breeze from
N N East and fine at 11 p.m. finished
boiling latter part stowed
down the oil there being 8 bbls of oil
and 8 bbls of Roddy So ends this day

Sept 4th

1857

Remarks onboard Friday Sept 4th
First and middle part of these 24
hours gentle breeze from S West
and rainy Saw one school of Blackfish
toward three boats and chased them
one hour and then came on board
latter part fresh breeze from
N N West and cloudy Lat 33.15 Long 110.15

Sept 5th

1857

Remarks onboard Saturday Sept 5th
First of this day fresh breeze from
W N West and cloudy middle
part calm latter part gentle
breeze from S West and cloudy
Sent down the fore topmast and
set up all of the head rigging
Saw two schools of Porpoises also to
ships supposed them to be
Merchantmen bound N East of here

Sept 6th

1857

Remarks onboard Sunday Sept 6th
First part of this day gentle breeze
from S West and cloudy latter part
middle and latter part of this day
gentle breeze from N East and
fine weather Saw two schools of
Porpoises Lat 32.47 Long 110.03

Sept 7th

1857

Remarks onboard Monday Sept 7th
First and middle part of this day
gentle breeze from N East and
fine weather latter part gentle
breeze from S East and fine
Set up the jibboom Sies and rove
new lanyard Saw two schools
of Porpoises and one school of
Grampuses Lat 32.28 Long 110.15
