Saw Grampuses and one Shoal of
Porpoises Lat 32.38 Long 41.44

Sept 10th

First part of this day gentle breeze
from S East middle and latter
gentle breeze from S West to S East
on bent the Flying Jib and repaired
it so ends this day Lat 33.05 Long 43.43

1857

Remarks onboard Friday Sept 11th
First and middle part of this day gentle
breeze from S East with rain
latter part fresh breeze from N West
and Squally Saw one Shoal of Grampuses
Saw a Brig supposed to be a
Merchantmen Clearing N West bent
the Flying Jib Lat 33.05 Long 43.43

First and middle part of these 24
hours gentle breeze from N West
and Cloudy latter part Calm
Lat 33.05 Long 45.48

1857

Remarks onboard Sunday Sept 13th
All of these 24 hours gentle breeze from
N West and fine weather
Lat 34.45 Long 44.15

1857

Remarks onboard Monday Sept 14th
All of these 24 hours gentle breeze
from N West and fine weather
So ends this day. A. H. Well

Remarks onboard Tuesday Sept 15th
All of these 24 hours gales from
N West with a heavy swell heaving
from S West laying too under
top reefed Foresail and Storm
Trysail Lat 34.46 Long 45.50

Sept 16th
1857

Remarks onboard Wednesday Sept 16th
First and middle part of these 24 hours
gentle breeze from N West with a
heavy swell heaving from the
S West latter part gentle breeze
from N East and fine on bent
the Foresail and repaired it
Lat 34.30 Long 46.50

Sept 17th
1857

Remarks onboard Thursday Sept 17th
First part of this day gentle breeze
from S East and fine weather
middle and latter part Wind
by S West with Squalls bent the
Foresail caught one dolphin
Lat 35.14 Long 48.27

Sept 18th
1857

Remarks onboard Friday Sept 18th
First and middle part of this
day fresh breeze from N West
with Squalls latter part gentle
breeze from S West and fine weather
Lat 35.06 Long 46.38

Sept 19th
1857

Remarks onboard Saturday Sept 19th
First part of this day gentle
breeze from S West and fine
middle and latter part A latter
part Wind West and fine
Saw one Shoal of Grampuses
Lat 35.46 Long 46.37
