Sunday-25-

Fresh S.E. trades and squally weather. Vessel going along on port tack under upper topsails. Boiling No obs.

Moderate S.E. trades and good weather. Course S. Got through boiling this morning.

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Tuesday-27-

Fresh S.E. trades and good, clear weather. Been steering by the wind, on port tack, with all sail out, heading S. by W. Saw some finbacks

Wednesday-28-

Moderate S.E. trades and fair weather. Vessel going by the wind on port tack. Saw some finbacks. Stowed 56 barrels of oil.
