Tuesday - 22.

Moderate easterly winds and fair weather. Vessel cruising. Got through hailing.

Fresh easterly winds and fair weather. Seas high. Vessel cruising under short sail. Boiling. Stowed 52 bbls. of oil today.

Easterly winds and rather strong. Seas high. Weather cloudy and foggy. Vessel cruising under upper topsails. Stowed 53 bbls of oil today.

Saturday - 26.

Strong winds and still from the east. Sea rough. At sunrise saw a school of bulls and got one big whale. Cut in. Got head. While cutting, school of whales passed by ship.

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Sunday - 27.

Very strong N. E. winds and weather rather clear. Sea very rough. Vessel lying to on port track under main lower topsail. Boiling.

Monday - 28.

Very strong N. E. winds and clear weather. Sea very rough. Vessel cruising under lower topsails. At 9 a.m. saw a school of small whales and got two. Cut them in, and it was some cutting.

Tuesday - 29.

Strong N. N. E. winds and fair weather. Sea very rough. Vessel cruising under easy sail. Got through boiling.

Lat. 33-00

Long. 47-29

Wednesday - 30.

Strong N. N. E. winds and weather a little cloudy. Sea rough. Vessel cruising under lower topsails. Saw a muskell. Stowed 79 bbls. of oil today.

Strong N. N. E. winds and fair weather. Sea very rough. Laying to under lower topsails.
