Friday-22-

Strong easterly winds and squally weather. Vessel steering by the wind on starboard tack.

Saturday-23-

Light easterly winds and dark, overcast weather with an occasional rain squall. Vessel going along by the wind on starboard tack. One merchant vessel in sight.

Sunday-24-

Light N.E. winds and squally weather. Vessel going by the wind on starboard tack.

Lat. 25.00

Long. 42.35

Monday-25-

Light to fresh easterly winds and clear weather. Vessel by the wind on starboard tack till 4 P.M. and then on port tack. Saw land.

Lat. 23.35

Long. 43.50

Tuesday-26-

Fresh E.N.E. winds and clear weather. Vessel by the wind on port tack. At 3.30 P.M. saw a large whale off the weather bow going to windward. Did not lower. No chance.

Lat. 24.40

Long. 43.56

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Wednesday-27-

Strong N.N.E. winds and squally weather. Vessel being steered by the wind heading about E. by S. Sea rather rough.

Lat. 25.25

Long. 41.34

Thursday-28-

Strong rain and wind and thunder squalls mostly from the N.N.E. all day. Seas smoothing down some. Vessel going along by the wind on port tack.
