Sunday Jan the 19th commences with fine breezes from the South
 Lat 15.39 S W hauled down the the Main topmast stays saw a brig
 Lon 55.14 standing to the Northward Middle and later part
 stiff breezes going & not so ends this day.

Monday Jan the 20th commences with fine fine breezes from
 Lat 18 S W the East ward, saw a sail to the windward standing
 Lon to the Northward Middle and later part the same
 the catch employed in ships duty so ends this day

Tuesday Jan the 21st commences with fine breezes from the
 Lat S W East ward fore part set up the Main rigging
 Lon later part rolled at down and hauled down the stays
 Middle and later part light breezes, and pleasant
 weather so ends this day

Wednesday Jan the 22nd commences with fine breezes from
 Lat 22.48 S W the South East Middle and later part the same all
 Lon hands Employed in fitting the rigging so ends this day

Thursday Jan the 23rd commences with fresh breezes from the
 Lat 24.17 S W Northward shifted the standing sails carried away
 Lon the 2nd Stalward block stays and hauled in the
 sail Middle part fresh breezes at 11 AM parted the
 1st S, sail took and took in the sail later part light
 breezes, saw two sails bound to the Northward at 2 PM and
 4 PM ends this 24 hours Painting Boats

Friday Jan the 24th commences with light breezes from the
 Lat S W North, set the 1st S at 7 AM Middle part light breezes
 Lon and pleasant weather, later part the same
 hauled to the southward, all hands employed
 in ships duty so ends this day

Saturday Jan the 25th commences with light breezes from the
 Lat S W South, Middle part light breezes
 Lon and pleasant weather at 6 PM raised a spout
 but lost the run of it saw black fish at 9 PM
 a sail in sight a head all hands Employed
 in ships duty so ends this day

Sunday Jan the 25th commences with light winds from the Southward
 Lat 28.10 S W hauled ship at 10 AM heading to the westward raised whales at
 Lon 42.56 6 PM peaked then hump back Middle part light breezes
 and pleasant weather later part the same so ends this day

Monday Jan the 26th commences with fresh breezes from the
 Lat 29.49 S W Northward set the standing sails at 8 PM, saw a sail
 Lon 44.46 standing to the westward a brig Middle and later part
 the 1st S shifted the standing sails, saw a
 course 55 W brig standing to the eastward at 5 PM, all hands
 when she will go employed in mending sails on bent the 1st S and set
 it a new one so ends this day

Tuesday Jan the 27th commences with light breezes from the
 Lat 30.36 S W North, at 8 AM wind to the South East, hauled down the
 Lon 45.27 standing sails, squall of rain braced round the yards
 on the larboard tack, Middle and later part light
 winds and pleasant weather, all hands Employed in
 mending sails so ends this day

Wednesday Jan the 28th commences with light breezes from
 Lat 31.32 S W the Southward and pleasant weather, on bent the
 Lon 46.55 courses and bent new ones Middle part wind hauled
 to the South East, squared the yards and set the 1st S, standing
 sails, at 10 PM wind hauled to the Westward took
 in the 1st S, and braced up all hands Employed in mending

Thursday Jan the 29th commences with light winds from the Westward
 Lat 32.22 S W at 4 AM bent a new 1st S Middle part calm with light
 Lon 46.55 breezes from the westward, at 6 PM wind hauled to
 the Northward braced round, so ends this day saw
 a brig standing to the Northward

Friday Jan the 30th commences with fresh breezes from the
 Lat 34.59 S W South East and pleasant weather, on bent the
 Lon 50.42 Middle and later part the same, saw two sails standing
 to the Northward all hands Employed in mending

Saturday Jan the 31st commences with fresh breezes from
 the South East bent a new 1st S at 11 AM
 Middle and later part the same all
 hands Employed in ships duty
