Lat 8.1.34.8 sail set 2.46.33.19.1 Low land. Middle part the same
Lon 77.19.0 later part sent the 16th studing sail and
set the sail so ends this day all hands employed

Wednesday the 9th commences with light winds and pleasant
from the S and E. fitted the 16th stud and
Lat 30.26 sent it a left and set the sail Middle part light
Lon 77.48 later mending sails and fitting a hamper
so ends this day coops from 2 to 4 net

Thursday the 10th light winds from the S and E. and pleasant
N.W. shifted the studing sails so they could draw
Lat 28.31 Middle light winds later part freshened
Lon 79.10 employed in mending sails and caulking

Friday the 11th fine breeze and pleasant Middle part
N.W. fine breeze raised spinnaker at 9.00 Low land
Lat 26.31 20 minutes before 12 but could not get past bar 4
Lon 82.20 cables that stand down anchor and 20 minutes
came on board at 4.30. lowered 3 boats the sails
L. W and Bow Boats all hands employed mending

Saturday the 12th fine breeze and pleasant braced
N.W. forward and sent out studing sails saw
Lat a ship and exchanged colors at 5.00 showing
Lon 84.00 rainish colors her name was 8.20 her name was the
Sophie Middle and later part light breeze and
pleasant saw a spot sail by anchor did not see again

Sunday April the 13th light breeze and pleasant Middle rain
N.W. winds from S.E. to E. bearing N.W. by W with
Lat 22.35 all sail set set the 16th stud and 16th at 9.00
Lon 84.17 so ends this day

Monday Apr the 14th light winds from the S and E and pleasant
N.W. Middle the same later part on bent the fore sail
Lat 20.45 and bent a nother all hands employed
Lon 86.20 mending sails light breeze ship going S.W.
all sail out

Lon 88.47 later part on bent the 16th stud and bent a nother repard sails

Wednesday the 16th light winds and pleasant got the Potatoes
Lat 28.00 on deck and send them Middle part the same later
Lon 88.07 fine and pleasant all employed in ships duty

Thursday the 17th light winds and pleasant from the S and
course N.W. by E saw a large school of black fish Middle part
Lat 27.17 wind held to the S and E. held in the stud
Lon 89.06 sails and braced up wind later part
fuland by chals to the S and E with light breeze
fitted the M. runner so ends this day

Friday the 18th light winds from the S. with calms
Lat 26.32 Middle part the same later part study breeze
Lon 89.52 fitted the rigging aft so ends this day

Saturday the 19th light winds from the S and East and
Lat 25.18 pleasant Middle and later parts the same
Lon 91.45 all hands employed in ships duty

Sunday the 20th fine breeze from the Eastward and from
Lat 23.41 Middle and later part the same the later
Lon 93.50 part light winds so ends this day

Monday the 21st light winds from the Eastward
Lat 21.50 and pleasant Middle and later parts the same
Lon 95.05 turned up the M. Topmast back stays and
washed of outside so ends this day

Tuesday the 22nd light winds from the South East
and pleasant Middle fine later part
Lat 19.57 on bent the 16th stud and sail all hands
Lon 09.15 employed in making spun yarn

Wednesday the 23rd fresh winds and pleasant on bent
Lat 07.00 the spanker and bent a nother Middle part
Lon 99.22 fine later part turned up the M. runner
back stays so ends this day fitted the M. runner
