

Beik. Warsaw of Stonington being
Tuesday Oct the 28 Commences with light westerly winds
and pleasant layed a tack till 5.30 then traced
satatmen forward and stood in for the harbor of S. Fran-
57.44 Francisco and came too at 6.00 in whalers bay
and at 10.00 in 5 fathoms of water, there we found the boat
122.44 a USN ship of war and the Mores capt. Guishman
the Sarah of NY and the Melrose of Smith
and the Chahis both of AL. so ends this day

Wednesday the 29. pleasant weather got off a raft
of water and stowed it down

Thursday the 30th. pleasant weather with light winds
warped up to a berth in side of the rest and
got of a raft of water Mr Gallop came on board
as second mate, the Capt went over to the town
Mr Gallop Left again the same day

Friday the 31st. pleasant got off 2 boat loads of wood
and got a raft of cask a those started under
November

Saturday the 1st. pleasant got off 6 boatloads of wood and
the Capt. went to town and shot a deer, so ends

Sunday the 2nd. pleasant all this day got Charles left
on shore, then spent the rest of the day in
sporting the Capt went to town

Monday the 3rd. pleasant got off 4 boat loads of
wood the Capt came over from the town
lunched the bone and stowed down the wood

Tuesday the 4th. pleasant the Lar watch went on Liberty
and sent the M to sail and repaid it that 2 Deer

Wednesday the 5th. pleasant the Star watch went on Liberty

Thursday the 6th. pleasant 4 men took their departure
the rest of the watch came on board at 11, some went
a gunning lost a man and shot a deer and seal
To 1.40 to lost man

Friday the 7th. pleasant found the man and the Capt
went to town and back

in the port of St Francisco Capt Barmen
Saturday Nov. the 8, pleasant the S. Welch went on shore

Sunday the 9th up to Thursday the 13, nothing special occurring pleasant
all the while broke the punches to the wind left to day
heaving up the anchor to clear it

Sunday the 14th pleasant all the past days enjoyed our selves
the best way we could Friday and Saturday
to work mending the wind left and so

Monday the 17th. pleasant killed 3 bullock and finished
mending the wind left, the Charles Phelps
arrived with 1200 bbls of whale oil

Tuesday the 18th. pleasant hung the wind left and took
at other little jobs Mr Laent a gunning
and brought back 2 Deer the Philenia
sailed at 3 P.M. so ends this day

Wednesday the 19th. pleasant the S. Phelps came over
to her anchorage nothing else special

Thursday the 20th. some goes a hunting and some
the shore, got 3 deer, and several foul

Friday the 21st. pleasant the Cooper went to Sapa
and the Mores cooper her oil. the Capt and lady
Saturday Capt Pendleton my self and boats crew went
over to Vitrols bastion on a excursion of
hunting and a very pleasant time we had

Sunday the 22nd. the Montaguena capt Baker came
in to the harbor.

Monday the 24th. the Morrison and Louvre Capts
Green's came in at 4 P.M. nothing else special

Tuesday the 25th. pleasant sent a hunting and killed 3 deer
we arrived back to the ship from our excursion of the 20th

Wednesday the 26th. all hands employed in their duty
the 27th 28, and 29th pleasant spent the time at
a great deal as could expect in hunting and gaming
