

Dark Warsaw at the Tres Maria Islands
Thursday the 15th of Jan Bonts with light winds and
pleasant got under way and run down
Lat 21.25 to the south side of the island and came
to in 10 fathoms of water went to look
for wood found a plenty but a very bad
place to get it

Tres Maria Islands
Friday the 16th pleasant got off some wood etc

Saturday the 17th pleasant got off 6 Boat loads
of wood. saw the Louse and the 6 Phelps

Sunday the 18th Bonts and Encls with strong
Lat 21.29 westerly winds and rain took some
Long 106.13 observations and found this place in Lat 21.29

Monday the 19th Strong breezes with rain got off 8 Boat
loads of wood and stored down some

Tuesday the 20th Fine weather and pleasant got off
7 Boat loads of wood spoke a Launch here
after shell fish hole about 12 fms
Dated all hands to quarters and covered the boat
and garments for them from the rain

Wednesday the 21st pleasant got off 3 loads and
5 pate loaded

Thursday the 22nd pleasant all hands on shore cutting
and caring down wood

Friday the 23rd Bonts with pleasant weather, chartered
the above mentioned Launch and got off 6 Boat
loads of wood and loaded her with 7 Boat loads
more at 5 PM heavy squall of wind and rain
which drove her ground the Island sent
a Boat to look for her but did not find her
came on board at 8 PM

Saturday the 24th Strong Easterly winds at 2 AM the
Launch came back after throwing overboard
1/2 of the wood came off at 12 with a nether down
with 5 Boat loads stored down the wood and got
off some sticks for charcoal

Bound to the Sandwich Islands 1846
Sunday Jan the 25th Bonts with fine breezes from the N.E. and
pleasant at 7 AM the S Boat went on shore
after iron poles and the Bow Boat went after
2 men that left the S. Howland that is gone
covered with us at 4 PM weighed our anchor and
took our departure from the Tres Maria
Islands bound to the Sandwich Islands

Monday the 26th Bonts with strong winds from the
Eastward with squalls of rain took in the
No down, Lar and Waist Boats and repaired them
course W Later part wind variable with squalls

Tuesday the 27th Bonts with strong winds from the S.E.
with squalls of rain Middle and later part
No down light variable winds and cloudy took in
the Star Boat and repaired her so ends

Wednesday the 28th Bonts with strong winds from the
Lat 20.08 Westward and slowly heeling S.S.W. Later
Long 106.13 part wind back to the S.W. at 6 PM
W.S.W. rose a new wheel rope etc

Thursday the 29th Bonts with strong N.E. winds and
Lat 19.06 Cloudy painted the quarter boats and
Long 106.13 took in the Bow Boat to repair made some
dance warps course W.S.W.

Friday the 30th Bonts with strong N.E. trades
Lat 18.47 and pleasant Painted the Bow Boat
Long 106.13 and made some rather steep etc

Saturday the 31st Bonts with trades and ends
Lat 18.52 the same set up the head stays and
Long 106.13 made some dance warps the ship
Leaking 600 strokes these 24 hours course W

Sunday Sunday Feb the 1st Bonts with fine breezes
Lat 18.54 from the N.E. and pleasant water high
Long 106.13 yesterday and to day saw nothing course
till 12 PM came later part W.S.W.
