Tuesday the 19th Boreas with strong S Easterly winds and
cloudy at 4 AM saw 2 humpbacks to windward hauled
out none and stood up to them at 5 PM shortened sail to dub
reef topsails at 10 took in all sail but m top thick
snow storm at 5 PM set the fore sail and kept
off N E by E set quarter watches

Wednesday the 20th Boreas with strong westerly winds and
foggy all sail set steering N E by E saw several
Lat 49 48 humpbacks later part weather the same at
Lon 17 55 3 PM saw a right whale light too and double
reefed the topsails too rough to lower at 6 shortened
sail heading N N W whale young ~~the~~ same

Thursday the 21st Boreas with strong westerly winds and
Lat 50 07 cloudy at 2 AM wore ship to the S W at 8 AM
Lon 17 52 1 made sail and steered N E by E at 5 PM saw
2 humpbacks

Friday the 22nd Boreas with light westerly winds and pleasant
at 11 lowered all 4 boats for a right whale
Lat 50 52 at 1 PM lowered again and the star boat
Lon 17 22 4 struck the West boat lost a line fast
to him 2 hours and dragged after 2 hours
came onboard at 4 PM and took in sail
thick snow storm heading S E wind N E.

Saturday the 23rd Boreas with light Easterly winds
Lat 50 54 and cloudy heading to the N W at 1 PM
Lon 17 25 5 backed ship heading S W saw several hump-
backs at 4 double reefed at 8 PM took in sail

Sunday the 24th Boreas with strong N and Easterly
the other winds and rainy wore ship occasionally

Monday the 25th Boreas with strong westerly winds
Lat 50 26 with rain at 1 PM made dulle reef topsails
Lon 17 2 10 and stood to the N N E saw several humpbacks

Tuesday 26th light winds from N N W and calm lowered
Lat 50 54 all 4 boats 4 times for right whale could not
Lon 17 1 37 get fast at 7 PM shortened sail to dulle reef
topsails

crucising on a whale ground Capt J S Barnum
Wednesday May the 27th Boreas with strong winds from the North
Lat 50 54 was heading to the westward under dulle reef
Lon 17 2 42 7 topsails at 10 AM wore ship heading N N E

Thursday the 28th light winds and calm at 8 AM lowered
all 4 boats for right whale at 11 lowered again
Lat 50 45 the Lar Boat struck and killed him and
Lon at 12 past 2 PM took him along side
finished cutting at 12 past 6 PM set the work

Friday the 29th Boreas with strong Easterly winds under
Lat 50 49 short sail boiling cleaned the bone and
Lon 17 2 24 stowed it away heading to the N N E

Saturday the 30th Boreas with strong Easterly gales and
rainy at 8 AM cooled down the works heading
to the S E at 6 PM wore ship to the N N E
at 10 PM more moderate started the works

Sunday the 31st Boreas with strong westerly winds and
Lat 51 02 foggy heading to the N N boiling at 8 PM wore
Lon 17 1 36 ship to the Eastward under short sail

Monday the 1st of June Boreas with light Easterly winds
Lat 50 42 and cloudy heading to the N E under short
Lon 17 2 10 sail boiling stowed down 105 lbs of oil
at 7 PM saw right whale

Tuesday the 2nd Boreas with light S Westerly winds
and pleasant at 4 AM saw several right
whales going to windward finished boiling
at 9 AM at 12 kept off to the S E saw several
finbacks - sent the new foresail

Wednesday the 3rd Boreas with light westerly winds and
Lat 51 12 pleasant stowed down 65 lbs of oil and
Lon 17 1 22 finished at 11 AM saw several finbacks later
part heading S with all sail set shortened

Thursday the 4th Boreas with light breezes from the S W
Lat 51 08 and pleasant run off to the N E saw several
Lon 17 0 08 finbacks short sail at 7 PM heading N N W
