Tuesday July 22nd Come with light westerly winds and
Lat 50 11 foggy heading S by W under whole topsails boiling
Lon 149 32 saw one ship at 7 PM shorten sail

Wednesday 23rd Come the same as above heading N by W
Lat 50 23 boiling saw nothing later part wind hails
Lon 150 01 southerly heading W by E whole topsails 105 11 11 11

Thursday 24th Come with light southerly winds
no. 1 and hazy heading East the main topmast
to the mast stowing down and boiling
no lookouts saw right whales the boats
the Lar boat struck and had the line
cut lowered again at 7 PM could not
get holt at 8 PM whales playing around
the ship. stowed down 110 bbls

Friday 25th Come with light westerly winds and
Lat 50 05 foggy stowed down the ballance 80 bbls
and washed ship at 8 PM heading S by E
saw nothing

Saturday 26th Come with light westerly winds &
Lat 50 30 foggy heading S by E made sail at 8 AM saw
Lon 150 18 nothing at 8 PM thick wore ship heading
west dulle reef topsails

Sunday 27th Come with westerly winds and thick
Lat 50 03 middle more clear steering S by W under
whole topsails and main sail saw a ship
to Leeward steering the same nothing else
in sight shorten sail at 8 PM 105 11 11 11 11 11

Monday 28th Come with strong westerly winds
no. 1 thick and rainy middle part more clear
saw 2 right whales going quick to windward
lowered 3 boats did not get holt later part
rainy shorten sail heading South

Tuesday 29th light westerly winds and foggy at 12 AM
Lat 49 25 saw a dead whale and hauled him a long side
Lon 151 50 and began to cut at 8 PM. lashed down and
started the works

ground J. S. Barmen master 18 1/2
Wednesday 29th light westerly winds and hazy
no. 1 finished cutting the whale had the 11 11 11 11 11 11
craft in hira appeared to have been killed
some time later very poor,

Thursday 30th light westerly winds and foggy heading south under
Lat 49 40 shorten sail boiling at 6 PM lashed down turned
Lon 151 34 up 60 bbls. later part thick and rainy

Friday 31st light westerly winds and thick fog heading
south under short sail stowed down 60 bbls of
oil and washed ship at 8 PM wore to the NW
and set dulle reef 11 11 and 11 11

Saturday August 1st light variable winds and fog
Lat 49 40 at 8 AM backed to the S by W at 12 merid all sail
Lon 151 10 set heading South saw a school of killers

Sunday 2nd light variable winds from the westward with
no. 1 thick fog lighting up by spells all sail set heading
S by W saw nothing set sea watches

Monday 3rd light winds from S by W and pleasant heading
Lat 49 50 S by W bent the 11 11 11 11 11 11 11 11 11 11
Lon 150 25 all sail set going 5 not at 6 PM saw a whale far away
run off did not find out what it was

Tuesday 4th light winds from the N by W and pleasant
Lat 49 10 at 7 AM steering South with all sail set repaired
Lon 150 10 the 11 11 11 11 11 11 11 11 11 11 11 11 11 11 11 11
the same scrim shoning fever raging high

Wednesday 5th light winds from N by W and pleasant
Lat 49 25 steering S by W all sail set that will draw
Lon 150 10 dried the bone and bunched it saw several
finbacks so ends thus 24 hours

Thursday 6th Light winds from N by W all sail set
Lat 49 25 that will draw steering S by E saw nothing
Lon 150 10 watches employed working on rigging
