

Remarks on board Bark "Warsaw" of Stonington  
Saturday Sep 19<sup>th</sup> Bore with brisk breezes from  
on the westward with squalls of rain. Middle &  
later parts light baffling winds with  
rain at 4 PM. Looked for black fish did not  
see them again 8 1/2 PM in top sail & main.

Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> Bore with light variable winds &  
Lat 6 40.50 rain at 6 AM. set top sail & main sails. Wind  
Long 161.39 calm. later part light winds from SE. heading  
SE. saw nothing.

Monday 21<sup>st</sup> Light baffling winds all these  
Lat 6 44.24 hours. heading southward saw nothing  
Long 161.41 watches employed in ships duty.

Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> light variable winds & pleasant  
Lat 6.35 heading southward all sail set  
Long 161.59 employed during forenoon. found them  
half rotten. fished a barrel of fish & ran off.

Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> light breezes from the South  
Lat 6.18 & East & pleasant heading to the SE. W.  
Long 162.59 saw nothing employed in ships duty.

Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> light variable winds & calm  
Lat 6.09 heading southward saw nothing  
Long 163.52 at 9 PM light breeze from Eastward.

Friday 25<sup>th</sup> Bore with light winds from SE  
Lat 5.21 & pleasant heading SE. W. repaired the  
Long 164.36 fore top sail, and bent it at 5 PM. raised  
sperm whales at sun down. lowered the  
Larled boats got up to them but was  
dark. came on board at 8 PM. to the NE  
at 12 midnight tacked to the SE.

Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> Bore with strong breezes from  
Lat 4.26 & pleasant at 7 AM. kept off SE. W. W.  
Long 165.12 saw nothing. on bent SE. top sail &  
repaired it at 6 PM. heading SE. W. W.  
necessary sail set 15 days out of port.

Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> Bore with fresh breezes from the SE. W.  
Lat 4.24 & pleasant heading SE. W. W. all necessary sail  
Long 167.16 set. going from 6 to 8 not saw nothing.

Monday 28<sup>th</sup> Bore with fine breezes from the Eastward  
Lat 4.14 & pleasant heading from SE. W. to SE. East  
Long 168.74 later part the same employed mending sails.

Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> Bore with fine breezes & pleasant steering  
Lat 4.39 & all sail set middle part the same as for  
Long 169.80 steering SE. bent the new courses took a  
Lunar by the Dis of Sun & moon which agrees  
with chronometer saw nothing.

Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> Bore with light SE. Easterly winds & pleasant  
Lat 4.29 steering SE. E. all sail set saw nothing  
Long 169.20 middle & later part the same as ends the month.

Thursday Oct 1<sup>st</sup> Bore with light Easterly winds  
Lat 5.57 & pleasant at 12 meridian kept off South  
Long 169.17 at 4 PM raised whales to windward 8 miles  
off. called them sperm whale & lowered all the  
boats & piled up there did not see them  
again came on board and kept our course.

Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> Bore with light breezes from SE. E.  
Lat 6.54 & pleasant heading south. all sail set  
Long 169.42 middle & later the same saw nothing.

Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> Bore with light Easterly winds  
Lat 8.19 & pleasant steering South  
Long 170.18 middle & later part the same steering SE.

Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> Bore with light Easterly winds &  
Lat 9.15 pleasant at 10 AM made Clarence Is.  
Long 171.16 waiting for it at 2 PM. went on shore  
with 2 boats got some coconuts.

Monday 5<sup>th</sup> light winds & pleasant laying  
Lat 9.32 off & on at Da Clarence Is. at 8 AM the Capt.  
171.15 Lady & the 2 mate went on shore found our  
part of the Is. natives did not land. they had  
the appearance of being savage the tide running strong.
