breeze from the Eastward
at 8 PM canoes came off to see if we wanted
a Pilot reported plenty of yams & pigs
sweet potatoes &c on shore

Saturday 10th Coms with fresh breezes from the
Lat 13.55 Eastward with squalls of rain at 5 AM made
Lon 177.22 the Is of Malina. Middle part light winds
the land about 20 miles off Later part
strong breezes from S.E. course S.W. 20

Sunday 11th Coms with strong Easterly winds
Lat 15.06 and cloudy all sail set but the S. 20
Lon 179.09 course S.W. 20 saw nothing Middle & L part

Monday 12th brisk breezes & pleasant all these
Lat 16.09 24 hours at 9 AM held up South sail
Lon 181.05 above saw nothing

Tuesday 13th Light winds & pleasant on the
Lat 17.11 wind holding S.W. all sail set
Lon 183.09 made the fore sail took a Lunar
sun & moon which agree with the Cron

from San & Louis Southeast O.S.B. 1846
Wednesday 14th Coms with light winds from S.E. & pleasant
Lat 18.27 holding South with all sail set fitted a sail
Lon 184.45 for a Tent and a smoke sail

Thursday 15th Light breezes from the Eastward and
Lat 21.50 pleasant all these 24 hours at 12 meridian
Lon 187.25 kept off S.W. watches employed making
a smoke sail the blacksmith making & painted
the Miz Mast rose a S & brace &c

Friday 16th Coms with light N.Easterly winds &
Lat 23.02 cloudy all sail set will draw cover
Lon 192.53 S.W. 20 Middle part the same Later part
wind held to the Northward with squalls
of wind and rain cover S.W. 20 in S.E.

Saturday 17th Coms with strong breezes and squalls
from the Northward at 12 AM in top Sail
Lat 24.45 all sails & main sail cover S.W. 20 at 5 AM
Lon 197.25 more moderate set the main sail at 4 PM 30
wind held to the Southward at 12 meridian
tacked to the S.W. at 4 PM all sail set holding
S.W. 20 Made some sheets &c

Sunday 18th Coms with brisk breezes from S.E.
Lat 25.34 with squalls at 12 AM in S.W. 20 middle
Lon 202.24 part light winds & pleasant Later part
wind held the S.E. East course S.W. 20

Monday 19th Coms with moderate breezes
Lat 26.08 from the Eastward & pleasant middle
Lon 207.05 the same course S.W. 20 Later part
the same made sheets for knifes
stuck a byrnie

Tuesday 20th Coms with brisk breezes from
Lat 26.27 the Eastward and cloudy middle part
Lon 213.34 the same Later part strong winds
at 8 PM in S.W. 20 all sails set
the Cooper employed making buoys
for the anchors at 9 PM in meridian S.E.
41 days out of Port
22 mo & 20 days from home
