

Remarks onboard Bark Waraw

Wednesday Nov 25th Boms with light winds from the NW and cloudy 2 boats went on shore for Elephant the other to work on the house. Sent down the M^{rs} Salant mast & house. M^{rs} D mast. The Lar boat brought off about 12 lbs of butter both boats onboard at 5 PM.

This day came civil account at 4 PM. Strong breezes from the SW & some sea heavy. Thursday 26th the above around the Point at 3 PM. More moderate landed some provisions and got a small Elephant. The waist boat crew on shore to stop.

Thursday 26th Boms with light winds & cloudy 2 boats went to the SW saw the remains of cask & pots and several other signs of there being Elephant there. Wase took 2 small Elephant. M^{rs} C went to the N Point & got 3 more the gang on shore got 11. Minced the blubber onboard.

Friday 27th Light westerly winds and hazy with fog got the blubber of that was killed yesterday some small hearing in.

Saturday 28th light NW winds with fog & rain. Loaded the blubber of 25 Elephant which weighed 18 lbs of oil. Later part light SW winds & pleasant the Lar boat went on shore and got some broke out water so ended this day.

Sunday 29th light westerly winds & foggy all this day went on shore to look a round light type.

Monday 30th light westerly wind with rain & fog all these 24 hours nothing else special out of gear.

Tuesday Dec 1st light westerly winds & pleasant went on shore to have a run saw Elephant.

Wednesday 2nd Strong North by winds all this day the Lat 54.55

at Macquarie Is. Capt B. L. Baranov. Thursday Dec 3rd Light westerly winds & pleasant. Boat went on shore at 8 AM and brought a load of blubber & Elop. PM went on shore all the boats for a tramp saw 6 Elop 3 miles off.

Friday 4th Boms with light winds from NW and pleasant. 4 men devised duty built a pen to put them in but they preferred returning to their stety. Went on shore with 2 boats killed 4 Elop did not bring the blubber onboard could not.

Saturday 5th Boms with light winds from NW & pleasant started to go around the Point but come back being too rough went on shore & killed 4 Elop and piled the blubber up. Later part strong winds with squalls of rain & snow. What Yankee what next.

Sunday 6th Boms with strong westerly winds with squalls of hail rain & snow. Middle more moderate. Later part pleasant with light SW winds went on shore the ship swinging around with the tide the first time since laying here.

Monday 7th Strong SW winds all these 24 hours.

Tuesday 8th Boms with fresh breezes from SW with rain & fog. The waist boats crew came off at 9 AM went on shore at 6 PM later part moderate with fog. No Elephant on the beach and prospects dull.

Wednesday 9th Boms with strong SW winds & foggy. Middle & later more moderate went on shore some of the men did by fire & hurt himself.

Thursday 10th Light westerly winds & foggy all this day. Friday 11th Light westerly winds & pleasant went on shore & carried a boat across the point got the blubber killed on the 4 & 5th came onboard at 12 hove up the anchors and run 2 kedges in shore warped her in to 15 ft and let go both anchors paid out the chain & spliced the main brace strong keep her at the 9 Elephant.
