Tuesday Jan 19th Boms with strong NW winds with light squalls of rain under Double & single reef topsails at 10 AM in mainsail middle part wind hals NW all sail out but 3/8 at 5 PM

con E. N. Lat 32.5 S Lon 134.27 W

Wednesday 20th Boms with brisk breezes from NW and cloudy on land the 3/8 sail to repair all other sail set Middle part strong winds and foggy at 8 PM in 16 3/8 at 7 Double & single reef topsails at 9 double & main sail in con E. N. Lat 30.49 Lon 129.54 W

Thursday 21st Boms with strong winds from NW and thick at 8 AM all sail set put the water but blow bent the 3/8 sail set it Middle part pleasant at 6 PM in 16 3/8 steering ESE the Chella puer dragging took the irons off the men to wash and shift close put them on again con E. N. Lat 31.08 Lon 125.08

Friday 22nd Boms with strong breezes from NW and pleasant all sail out Middle part the same Later part light winds with passing clouds con E. N. Lat 31.81 Lon 120.08

Saturday 23rd Boms with light NW winds and hazy steering East with all sail out broke off the after hole and stowed down the shooke heads at 4 PM strong breezes double reef top heavy wind hals NW 3/8 Lat 30.48 Lon 117.08

Sunday 24th Boms with brisk breezes from NW and foggy at 8 AM all sail out but 3/8 sail set Middle the same later part wind west same sail no other

Monday 25th Boms with strong winds from NW and fog at 8 AM in 16 3/8 sail set Double the 3/8 handed the 3/8 and Main sail scudding off 3/8 at 3 PM a heavy sea broke on board stove in the cabin winders sent the oil lard a spinning about the cabin. & got the water out fitted the winders and set the main top sail at 6 reefed the fore top sail over Lat 32.56 Lon 108.08

Tuesday 26th Moderate breezes from NW with light squalls of rain sail out that will draw steering E. N. shifted the 3/8 at 6 in mainsail no observations

Cape Horn

Wednesday Jan 27th Light winds from the westward all the first part Middle wind hals to the NW all sail set steering East. Repairing sails. Lat 52.50 S Lon 100.14 W

Thursday 28th Boms with light winds from NW and cloudy at 4 PM wind hals to the westward all sail out steering E. N. sent 3/8 sail & repaired the 3/8 Lat 53.25 Lon 96.30

Friday 29th Boms with light winds from the westward and cloudy all sail out that will draw at 10 wind NW all sail drawing at 5 PM strong sails under Double reef topsails main sail in wet and rainy Lat 54.11 Lon 91.35

Saturday 30th Boms with brisk breezes from the westward with rain all sail out with orders at 6 AM steering ESE Middle & later part light winds and cloudy Lat 55.03 Lon 86.41

Sunday 31st Boms light winds from westward calm foggy Middle the same later part light winds from NW con E. N. no observations

Monday Feb 1st Boms with brisk breezes from NW and cloudy at 7 AM in 16 3/8 sail set at 10 in Main 3/8 at 3 PM set Main 3/8 con E. N. Lat 55.22 Lon 79.49

Tuesday 2nd All this day brisk breezes from NW and pleasant with passing clouds all sail set steering E. N. Lat 55.38 Lon 74.21

Wednesday 3rd Boms with brisk breezes from NW and cloudy steering E. N. at 9 AM made the Land. the Island of St. Felipe passed in shore at 12 noon at 4 PM of Cape Horn at 8 calm of Hermits Is. at 11 PM of Cape Horn with light wind from NW Lat 55.44 Lon 68.49

Thursday 4th Boms with light wind from NW and pleasant heading E. N. with all sail out the Cape in sight on our weather quarter at 12 noon in 16 3/8 sails at 2 double & 3/8 sails saw a ship at 4 PM steering westward Lat 56.11 Lon 65.55
