Tuesday March 17th All this day fine weather
light airs from S.W. bent Steer sails and
sent them aloft to set top gal steer fore & aft on
the lar side cow S.W. Lat 2425 Lon 3650

Wednesday 18th Light breeze from S.W. and pleasant
all this day all sail set will draw Steer sails
down & aloft 4 in all cow S.W. Lat 2355 Lon 3631
gubert the top sail and sent another

Thursday 18th Light baffling winds from the west
and pleasant on bent the top sail and repaired
it at 8 PM in span sail raised up wind S.W.
Lat 2225 Lon 3608

Friday 19th Breeze with light airs from the
westward and pleasant except a few showers rain
middle part light airs from S.E. cut Star steer
at 2 PM star wind hals to S.W. head in glass
employed in repairing the top gallant sail
Chromonion the most consequence of any thing
Lat 2253 Lon 3544

Saturday 20th Breeze with fine winds from
N.W. and cloudy at 2 PM tacked to the east
middle part steady at 11 AM raised the top
to make it set at 2 in top gallant sails
strong winds the rest of the day head S.W.
Lat 2233 Lon 3518

Sunday 21st Breeze with strong gales from
the N.W. with constant squalls of wind &
rain at 11 AM passed a brig heading Eastward
over clearance of topsails courses in at 6 PM hauled
to S.W. wind N under Double reef top sails
heavy squalls all this day no cheer

Monday 22nd Breeze with strong breezes from
and squally sail as above middle more moderate
at 8 reef out top at 6 PM got the main & fore
sails hals to S.W. Lat 2223 Lon 3547

Tuesday 23rd All this day calm with showers of
rain caught a shark &c

Wednesday March 24th Breeze with fine breezes from
S.W. with showers of rain steer out S.W. & left
fore waft steering S.W. this morning saw 2 brigs
steering S.W. Lat 2028 Lon 3571

Thursday 25th Breeze with strong winds from S.W.
at 9 AM squall in steer sails and set them
again middle part sent up a main royal
yard & sail and set it saw a sail a stern at 8 AM
in all steer main royal & top sail wind
hals to East and steering the rest of the day as usual

Friday 26th Breeze with strong breezes from
East and cloudy at 1 PM saw a brig ahead
at 9 AM parted the S.W. Galant back stay hauled
it and put up a preventer set the sails
at 10 AM came up with the brig and spoke
her a Brazilian from Rio Grand 43 days bound
to Byheel saw a bark and a brig ahead wind
baffling from S.W. to East at 6 PM they were 2 miles
off ahead and the other out of sight a stern
at 8 PM in top gallant sails S.W. at main S.W.
the brigs Lon 3550 Lat 16 19 Lon 3450

Saturday 27th Light winds from S.W. and squally
& sail in sight all bound Northward at 8 AM
wind headed us off to S.W. were ship
at 8 PM were sight heading S.W. no cheer

Sunday 28th Light winds from S.W. and
cloudy 11 sail in sight bound to the Sward
at 1 PM tacked to the Eastward at 4 PM exchanged
signals with a French brig Lon 3550 own 3640
also with a English Bark could not make out
her Lon at 6 PM tacked to the Sward wind S.W.
no cheer

Monday 29th Breeze with light airs from S.W.
at 10 AM squall of wind and rain from S.W. middle
part calm later part light winds from East
several sail in sight the later part light
winds from East heading S.W. the Lat
by the moons merse alt. 13.17 no cheer
