Tuesday March 30<sup>th</sup> Come with light winds  
from ESE heading NW at 8 AM sail in sight  
at 9 AM heavy squall from SE steering NE middle  
part light winds from NE heading ESE shifted  
main top & all sails no ice off the ice Lon 56.50.53

Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> Light winds from NE and pleasant  
heading ESE several sail in sight

Thursday April 1<sup>st</sup> Come with light winds from  
NE & pleasant heading ESE. saw several sail  
employed repairing sails & making sweeps and  
various other admiring showing which is the most  
Lat 40.5 Lon 53.43

Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> Light winds from the Eastward &  
pleasant at 10 AM tacked to the NE several sail  
in sight & bound southward & at 11 AM  
Lat 45.8 Lon 53.79

Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> Light winds from E and pleasant  
heading NWSE all sail set saw 1 sail  
employed repairing sails Lat 48.4 Lon 52.59  
calm from 8 PM till 12

Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> Come with calm & pleasant middle  
and later parts light breeze from ESE  
heading W 3 sail in sight Lat 42.10 Lon 52.57

Monday 5<sup>th</sup> Light baffling winds from NESE  
rumshon fever having high Lat 40.10 Lon 53.10

Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> Light breeze from SE at 6 AM  
out studding sails low & aloft saw 18 SE  
at 12 merid kept off SE 1/4 made a wind sail.  
Lat 45.1 Lon 53.18

Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> fine breeze from SE and pleasant  
steering NW all sail out at 2 PM saw a brig &  
a steam boat

Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> fine breeze from SE & pleasant  
at 6 AM made the land at 12 merid Cape St Roque  
Lays 14 dis 12 miles saw a number of boats, merrons  
shifted the main top sail and repaired the main sail

from Rio de Benaze (Home O. Barnum m)  
Friday April 9<sup>th</sup> Come with fresh trades from SE  
steering NE middle part light winds all sail set  
at 8 PM baffling winds from NESE and squally  
inn all studding sail

Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> Light variable winds from NESE  
with squalls of rain at 11 AM out studding sail  
at 9 took them in again Lat 2.45 Lon 56.334

Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> Light baffling winds with showers  
of rain middle & later parts the same  
no ice Lat 1.17 Lon 57.57

Monday 12<sup>th</sup> Light baffling winds and calm  
with showers of rain. driving skrimshoring  
Lat 0.47 Lon 58.69

Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> Light airs & calm all the day  
Lat 0.26 Lon 49.05

Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> Light airs from NE with squalls  
Lat 0.04 Lon 49.53

Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> Light airs from NE to NESE heading  
to the North & Eastward the cane fever broke &  
sifts, boxes, tubs, stool stands and various other  
in vogue now the old woman acting the most  
conspicuous part. Lat 0.22 Lon 49.55

Friday 16<sup>th</sup> Come with light breeze from  
NE at 4 AM had a severe thunder storm  
the middle & later parts light breeze  
from NESE to NE Lat 0.51 Lon 49.54

Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> Come with light breeze  
from NE with squalls of rain at 6 AM  
seized Tom Whiggs. and flogged him  
at 7 tacked ship to NESE wind baffling  
a heavy shower of rain. Lat 4.5 Lon 42.12  
the Capt flogged the man for Insolence Language

Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> Come with light NE trades  
middle part had a heavy squall of rain  
later part fresh breeze heading NESE  
Lat 1.41 Lon 42.57
