

Monday April 19th All this day brisk breeze from N.E. stood fast heads saw 2 sails at 12 merid keep off S.W.

Tuesday 20th All this day breezes from N.E. & equally steering N.W. all sail out

Wednesday 21st All this day fresh N.E. trades as out top standing sails steering N.W. this morning had a fight to keep peace
Lat 4.10 Lon 46.42

Thursday 22nd Strong N.E. trades in main & standing sail and repaired the top gallant sails saw nothing through squalls in N.E. & S.W.
Lat 6.04 Lon 48.4

Friday 23rd Brisk N.W. trades and pleasant saw a sail steering N.W. Nothing else at 11 in N.E.
Lat 8.08 Lon 50.49

Saturday 24th Moderate trades all this day saw nothing the scrimshaw & crew raging as usual
Lat 11.44 Lon 54.46

Sunday 25th Breeze with brisk breeze from N.E. & pleasant at 7 A.M. out fore & main topmast standing sails & main top & S. sail middle part wind and weather the same later part strong breeze at 2 in standing sail to the main
Lat 15.56 Lon 66.16

Monday 26th Breeze with strong breeze from East and pleasant all sail out & standing steering N.W. saw 3 vessels 2 brigs & ship to French brig passed close to us all of them steering N.W.
Lat 16.06 Lon 68.50

Tuesday 27th Breeze with light breeze from East with light showers of rain middle the same steering N.W. all sail out standing sails fore & aft low & aloft & in all sail nothing but gulf weed and a plenty of that
Lat 18.27 Lon 60.05

Wednesday 28th Breeze with moderate breeze from East to N.E. with light squalls of rain middle part baffling winds from E to South later part steady S.W. winds & pleasant commenced taring down the rigging. saw N.W. & S.W.
Lat 20.45 Lon 60.52

Thursday 29th Breeze with light steady breeze from N.E. & pleasant took up the sheeting on the S. side finished the taring of the rigging all sail but as above standing sails fore & aloft steering N.W. & S.W. middle & later parts wind & weather the same saw nothing
Lat 22.15 Lon 62.46

Friday 30th Breeze with light breeze from N.E. and pleasant all sail set that will draw 2 studdings forward & 4 aft set a top gallant sail for lower studding sail finished taring down and replacing the skotchen & refined a barrel of slush for family use middle & later parts the wind & weather the same
Lat 23.46 Lon 63.58

Saturday May 1st Breeze with light breeze from N.E. & pleasant washed the ship outside & inn for painting middle & later parts light squalls of rain steering N.W. by N.W. & S.W. all sail out as above
Lat 25.12 Lon 64.58

Sunday 2nd All this day light breeze from N.E. & pleasant steering N.W. & S.W. saw 2 sail on the weather beam and schooner steering N.W. nothing else
Lat 26.23 Lon 65.43

Monday 3rd Breeze with light breeze from N.E. with light showers of rain shifted the standing sails from the lar main to the other fore painted the ship outside at sunset in lar lower studding sail in sight through the day bound to the S.W. West nothing else special
Lat 27.55 Lon 66.52
