

Remarks on Tuesday June 17th 1820

This morning begins with light winds and pleasant weather at sunrise sent 2 boats a fishing caught 729 fish latter part fresh gales and thick weather
So ends this day 20 days out Port

Remarks on Wednesday June 18th

This morning comes in with light winds and thick weather at 9 AM 2 Boats started a fishing - returned and caught 1054 fish. yawl boat employed in fishing water and water
So Ends this Day 21 Days out Port

Remarks on Thursday June 19th 1820

This morning comes in with fresh breeze took in two boats got under weigh and stood farther up the harbour and came to anchor in 10 fathoms water at 10 came on the Rhinoceros of 1 Ennet Capt Low - Latter Part one boat on shore a wooding the remainder of the crew
So Ends the Day

22 Days out Port

Remarks on Friday June 20th 1820

This morning begins with fresh breeze & rainy people employed in unloading lots of ships early till 2 boats water got one boat head wind and windy other lots of ships Daily
So ends the day with stiff breeze
23 days out Port

Remarks on Saturday June 21st 1820

This morning comes in with fresh breeze and thick weather - sent 2 Boats a fishing at 4 came on board with 595 fish - one boat lost her rudder & broken went on board Capt Low and got a barrel of rigging for rudder Latter Part fresh breeze So Ends the Day
24 Days out Port

Remarks on Sunday June 22nd 1820

This morning comes in with light winds and pleasant weather got in all Boats and at 6 AM got under weigh from the Harbour called tobacco Ann - in Co with in Capt Low in the Attention at 9 AM visited the main Islands
company with a number of people at 10 AM here too unloading of Lin
Thinking it not prudent to run
