

Remarks on Thursday June 23rd 1828

This morning comes in with fresh breezes and thick weather on each all sail fell in with delay of ice, and at sunset came to an anchor near Cape Charles with our best lower in ten fathoms water in company with Capt Low -

so ends this day - 26 Days out Port ^{wind East}

Remarks on Tuesday June 24th 1828

This morning comes in with fresh breezes and thick foggy weather - got out one whale boat sent her to try for fish - at 11 AM returned and caught nothing so ends this day with thick weather attended with snow some day in Chumney tittle and 27 days out Port

Remarks on Wednesday June 25th 1828

This morning comes in with light winds & clear weather at 2 AM got under weigh in company with Capt Low with the wind at W, and at 2 PM returned the current setting to the westward we could not keep company with Capt Low, on account of our dull sailing so ends the day 2 days in Chumney tittle and 28 days out Port

Remarks on Thursday June 26th 1828

This morning comes in with fresh breezes at 5 AM got under weigh from Chumney tittle - and at 8 AM about Cape Charles - bearing N 60 E miles Distance, at 11 AM Cape Lewis bore NW by W 3 leagues distance - at 11 PM came to anchor in spotted Island so ends the day 29 days out Port

Remarks on Friday June 27th 1828

This morning comes in with light winds and cloudy weather sent the yawl boat a gunning, and fishing at Lt. M. station with nothing People employed in sundry jobs of ship duty sent over the topsail topgallant sail - foresail - and softs so ends the day 30 days out Port and one in the spotted Islands

Remarks on Saturday June 28th 1828

This morning comes in with fresh breezes and foggy weather at 4 AM got under weigh in company with Capt Low - Made fast fresh Breezes and thick weather made and took in sail occasionally and at 1 PM came to anchor in Long Island with our best lower made ship and sundry other jobs of ship duty

31 days out Port

Came on steered from Spotted Island to Long Island at 2 PM in fore sail with a little breeze
