

Remarks on Friday July 10th 1820

This morning comes in with thick rainy weather all boats a fishing - caught 1437 fish so ends the day with thick rainy weather 51 Days from Portland

Remarks on Saturday July 19th 1820

This morning comes in with thick rainy weather all hands employed in fishing getting mud and water &c have up our anchors, and moved ship again in latter part rainy weather and cald so ends the day 52 days from Portland

Remarks on Sunday July 20th 1820

This morning begins with thick foggy weather land all sail to day - and sundry other jobs of ships duty so ends the day 53 days from Portland

Remarks on Monday July 21st 1820

This morning comes in with pleasant weather all boats a fishing caught 2256 fish 54 days from ^{one man sick} Portland

Remarks on Tuesday July 22d 1820

This morning comes in with light wind and pleasant all boats a fishing caught 1176 fish - one man sick 55 days out Port

Remarks on Wednesday July 23d 1820

This day begins with pleasant weather 2 boats a fishing caught 1022 fish 56 days out

Remarks on Thursday July 24th 1820

This morning comes in with moderate weather all boats a fishing - one man sick and unfit for duty so ends the day Caught 1400 fish 57 Days from Portland

Remarks on Friday July 25th 1820

This morning begins with easterly wind and pleasant weather all hands employed in fishing caught 1289 fish so ends the day 58 days out Portland

Remarks on Saturday July 26th 1820

This morning begins with thick rainy weather with squalls of wind sent 2 boats a fishing against one boat in the breaker - lost some lines our ship out boat rode and a number of articles - hauled out the boat and towed her on board again - filled three barrels water so ends this day 59 days out Portland

Remarks on Sunday July 27th 1820

This morning comes in with pleasant weather unmoored ship and moved her again, loaded sails to day and so forth - doped plenty of caplin - ends the day 60 days from Portland

Remarks on Monday July 28th 1820

This morning comes in with fresh breeze and brany weather caught 2737 fish 61 days from Portland

Remarks on Tuesday July 29th 1820

This morning begins with thick rainy weather and heavy gale from the North latter part heavy gale from the West with heavy rain boats stop from fishing caught 700 fish - 62 days from Portland

Remarks on Wednesday July 30th 1820

This morning begins with good weather, got plenty of bait sent boat a fishing caught 801 fish latter part light wind 63 days from Portland
