Monday Jan. 14th

The first part of these 24 hours commences cloudy we shook out the reef of the fore sail it becomes more pleasant heading S.W. and part more pleasant set the sturken on the ship and set west list part rather of the until six o'clock then more pleasant shook out the reef from the main to sail heading S.W. S.W.

Tuesday January 15th in lat 29° 14'

Comences rain pleasant and warm heading S.W. by S.W. at starboard watch making rope and rigging fore sail at 10 at starboard and one fore sail and lent across the the 2nd part very pleasant and warm heading S.W. the last part very warm in the air all hands in place in the ships deck.

Wednesday Jan the 16th lat 30° 21'

Comences very warm and calm at 2 o'clock a man at our mast head cried out there she comes at one hour the starboard and Larlow Bats and quite for the wind and rain with out much and part calm and clear in rings of rain heading S.W. last part warm but cloudy then rain with out heading S.W.

Thursday Jan the 17th in lat 31° 3'

Comences warm and cloudy starboard watch in flood in getting out first water and part of goods and signs rain heading S.W. by S.W. at 10 o'clock a small strike us with a squall and much rain at 11 o'clock was called and let go the fore sail and at 12 o'clock in the main top sail close reefed fore and main top sails and the wind blew from the starboard over the fore top mast stamper at 1 o'clock rather more calm we set the fore and main top sails at 10 am furled the fore and galant sails before 11 am shook all the reefs away and in the main top sail we set up the fore sail set the fore and fore top mast the sail it then shook away at 12 o'clock more moderate heading

Friday Jan the 18th in latitude 31° 3'

The first part of these 24 hours commences more moderate and warm shaking out the reef of the fore sail at 10 am it begins to rain again and then rain for and after for the main sail and set the main top sail with the dunn heading S.W. by S.W. the 2nd part rather more moderate at 10 o'clock set the fore and main top sails the fore top sail and 2 out of the main top sail one out of the main sail and 2 out of the main top sail and set the main sail at the sturken the last part whole sail breeze heading S.W. to 10 o'clock free

Saturday Jan the 19th in lat 32° 14' long

The first part of these 24 hours more pleasant and warm heading S.W. the 2nd part part weather the last part of these 24 hours off the mouth of the river whole place heading S.W.

Sunday Jan the 20th in lat

The first part fair wind heading S.W. the 2nd part calm and warm at 10 am sent out the fore top galant sail and the fore top mast sturken sail and main top galant sturken sail the last part pleasant and warm heading S.W.

Monday Jan the 21st lat 33° 14'

Comences very warm and with a fine breeze from the north West at 10 am it began to blow rain from the north West top sails fore and aft then sent down fore and main top galant sails the wind still increasing so we had to let the fore and main top sails and fore and main top sails and fore and main top sails heading S.W. the 2nd part fair wind heading S.W. the 3rd part fair wind heading S.W. the last part more moderate set the top sails and fore and main top sails and fore and main top sails and fore and main top sails heading S.W.

Tuesday Jan the 22nd in lat 33° 34'

Comences pleasant but with a squall of rain from the fore top sail heading S.W. at 10 o'clock a small strike us with a squall and much rain at 11 o'clock was called and let go the fore sail and at 12 o'clock in the main top sail close reefed fore and main top sails and the wind blew from the starboard over the fore top mast stamper at 1 o'clock rather more calm we set the fore and main top sails at 10 am furled the fore and galant sails before 11 am shook all the reefs away and in the main top sail we set up the fore sail set the fore and fore top mast the sail it then shook away at 12 o'clock more moderate heading

Wednesday Jan the 23rd in lat 34° 16' long 15° 30'

Comences pleasant with the wind S.W. and a fine count appears at 10 o'clock a small strike us with a squall and much rain at 11 o'clock was called and let go the fore sail and at 12 o'clock in the main top sail close reefed fore and main top sails and the wind blew from the starboard over the fore top mast stamper at 1 o'clock rather more calm we set the fore and main top sails at 10 am furled the fore and galant sails before 11 am shook all the reefs away and in the main top sail we set up the fore sail set the fore and fore top mast the sail it then shook away at 12 o'clock more moderate heading

Thursday Jan the 24th in lat 34° 35'

Comences pleasant heading S.W. with moderate breeze of wind and part fair with fair wind heading S.W. last part pleasant with a fine sail breeze of wind heading S.W.
